ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION 3 17 PM '96

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of full age and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together and do hereby and by these Articles of Incorporation, unite and associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho for the purposes hereinafter stated.

I.

That the name of the said corporation shall be: Automated Structures Incorporated.

II.

That the term for which this corporation shall exist shall be in perpetuity.

III.

The name of the corporation's initial registered agent is Jerry Smith, who is located at the initial registered office of the corporation, 2070 E. Commercial Street, Meridian, Idaho, 83642.

IV.

The object and purpose for which this corporation is formed shall be to engage in construction and sale of new single family dwellings.

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In furtherance, and not in limitation of the powers conferred by statute, the Board of Directors is expressly authorized:

To make and to alter Bylaws of this corporation, to fix the amount to be reserved as working capital over and above its capital stock and paid in capital, and to authorize and cause to be executed mortgages and liens upon the real and personal property in this corporation.

If the Bylaws so provide, to designate two or more of its members to constitute and execute committee which committee shall, for the time being, as provided in said resolution or in the Bylaws of this corporation, have and exercise any or all of the power of the Board of Directors in the management of the business and affairs of the corporation, and have power to authorize the seal of this corporation to be affixed to all papers which may require it.

Pursuant to the affirmative vote of the holders of at least a majority of the stock issued and outstanding, having voting power given at a stockholders meeting duly called for that purpose, or when authorized by the written consent of at least a majority of the holders of the voting stock issued and outstanding, the Board of Directors shall have the power and authority at any meeting to sell, lease, or exchange all of the property and assets of this corporation, including its goodwill and its corporate franchises, upon such terms and conditions as its Board of Directors deem expedient and for the best interest of the corporation.

This corporation may in its bylaws confer power upon its directors in addition to the foregoing, and in addition to the powers and authorities expressly conferred upon them by statute.

VI.

The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have the authority to issue is 100,000. Such shares are to consist of one class only having no par value. No distinctions shall exist between the shares of this corporation and all such shares shall have the same rights in the corporation.

VII.

All or any portion of the capital stock may be issued for cash or in payment for real or personal property, services, or any other right or thing of value, for the uses and purpose of the corporation, and when so issued shall become and be fully paid, the same as though paid for in cash at par; and, the directors shall be the sole judges of the value of any property, right, or thing acquired in exchange for capital stock.

'VIII.

From time to time the capital stock may be increased according to law, and may be issued in such amounts and proportions as shall be determined by the Board of Directors and as may be permitted by law.

IX.

The private property of the stockholders shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts to any extent whatsoever.
