

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE IDAHO BAPTIST
CONVENTION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO.

* * * * *

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS That we, the undersigned,
have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the
purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of
Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

FIRST: That the name of this Corporation shall be,
"The Idaho Baptist Convention of the State of Idaho."

SECOND: That the purpose for which it is formed is to
promote the preaching of the gospel, ministerial and general
education, the establishment and maintenance and assistance of
Baptist churches and Bible Schools and the care of worthy pastors
and wives or widows and their dependent children, and such other
religious, charitable and humane purposes as form a part of church
work, and to do all things incident to or reasonably necessary
to effect such purposes, and to acquire, hold, lease, sell, convey,
mortgage, or otherwise encumber, such personal and real property
as shall be necessary for the business of and to promote the
object of such organization, but in no case for pecuniary profit.

THIRD: That the place where its principal business
is to be transacted shall be Boise, Idaho.

FOURTH: That the term of existence of said corporation
shall be fifty years.

FIFTH: That the number of its trustees shall be five,
and that the names of said trustees as elected for the first year
are as follows:

SIXTH: that this corporation is a membership corporation without capital stock and is not organized for pecuniary profit.

SEVENTH: That on the second day of October, 1913, at Blackfoot, Idaho, an election for the trustees of this corporation was held and at such election a majority of the members of said corporation were present and voted. That notice of the time and place of holding such election was given by publication for two weeks in The Blackfoot Optimist, a weekly newspaper published in Blackfoot, Idaho, where said election was held, and also by posting a like notice in a conspicuous place upon the building where said election was held for the same length of time before said election.
