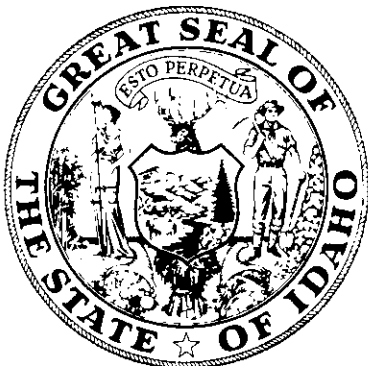

ARTICLE VI.

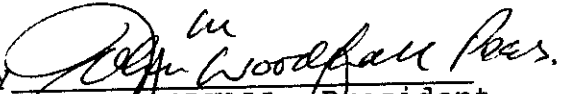
There are no suits pending against the corporation in any court.

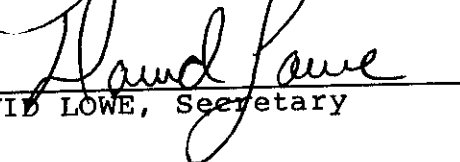
