Jerome, Idaho in the County of Jerome and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ST. BENEDICT'S HOSPITAL FOUNDATION, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all natural persons of full age, citizens of the United States and residents of the State of Idaho, have this
day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming
and organizing a corporation pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 10
of Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and we hereby make, subscribe and execute the following Articles of Incorporation, and we do hereby certify:

ARTICLE I Name

The name of this corporation is ST. BENEDICT'S HOSPITAL FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III Place of Business

The location and postoffice address of the registered office of this corporation, and the place where the principal business of this corporation is to be transacted shall be 709 North Lincoln Street, Jerome Idaho.

ARTICLE IV Purposes and Powers

This corporation is a non-profit organization and is formed for benevolent and charitable purposes, and especially for the following:

(a) The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are charitable and are to concern themselves with the procurement and extension of financial aid toward the operation, maintenance and expansion of the facilities of the St. Benedict's Hospital, located in Jerome, Idaho, all to the end that the greatest possible amount of hospital service may be extended to the greatest possible number of persons in the area served by said St. Benedict's Hospital, The activities of the corporation shall be broad in scope and may include endowment of charitable clinics and wards, medical research, scholarships for interns and nurses, and other charitable activities of like nature.

- (b) The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for charitable and scientific purposes.
- (c) This corporation shall have and may exercise such powers as may be conferred upon a non-profit corporation by the laws of the State of Idaho and as may be necessary or expedient for the administration of the affairs and attainment of the purposes of this corporation, provided that in no event shall this corporation engage in activities which are not charitable in nature.
- (d) To take, hold, receive and enjoy all property and money that may be given, bequeathed, devised, conveyed or transferred to it, and to solicit, accept and receive contributions of money and property, and to apply such monies and property toward the operation, maintenance and expansion of the facilities of St. Benedict's Hospital.
- (e) All of the properties and assets of this corporation are irrevocably dedicated to charitable and scientific purposes. No part of the net earnings, properties or assets of this corporation on dissolution or otherwise shall enure to the benefit of any private person or individual or any member or director of this corporation, and on liquidation or dissolution all properties and assets of this corporation, remaining after paying or providing for all debts and obligations shall be distributed and paid over to one or more non-profit funds, foundations, or corporations organized and operated exclusively for charitable or scientific purposes, the principal functions of which are the providing of medical or hospital care, or medical research, and which are exempt from income taxation under the laws of the State of Idaho and from income taxation under the Internal Revenue laws of the United States of America. In the event said Board of Directors fails to select such a distributee or if the named distributee is not qualified to accept said distribution, then the property of the corporation shall be distributed to one or more non-profit charitable funds, foundations, or corporations having functions as stated in the preceding sentence, and similarly exempt from the designated classes of taxation, or to the State of Idaho, or to any political subdivision thereof, for charitable or scientific purposes, as shall be directed by decree of the District Court of the State of Idaho, in and for the County of Jerome, upon petition filed by any party concerned in the liquidation.

ARTICLE V Capital Stock

This corporation does not and shall not have any capital stock, and neither shall it issue to its members certificates representing capital stock.

ARTICLE VI Non-Profit Organization

Pecuniary profit is not an object of this corporation and it shall not be operated for pecuniary gain or profit to the members thereof.

ARTICLE VII.

There shall be no limitation in number of members and all numbers shall belong to one class and shall have full equality of rights. Hembers shall have no property rights in the corporation or in any of its property or assets.

ARTICLE VIII

The management of the affairs of this corporation shall be vested in a Seard of 33 Directors, and the terms of office, qualifications of directors and manner of election or appointment shall be provided for in the By-Laws.
