ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
BOISE BOWMEN, INC.
A Chartered Club
Of The
NATIONAL FIELD ARCHERY ASSOCIATION
And
STATE ARCHERY ASSOCIATION

We, the undersigned, being full age citizens of the United States, hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

Article 1 - Name

The name of this corporation shall be the Boise Bowmen, Inc.

Article 2 - Purpose

The purpose of this association shall be to foster, expand, and perpetuate the practice of field archery, and the spirit of good fellowship among all archers; to encourage the use of the bow in hunting of all legal game, birds, and animals, and cooperate with the National Field Archery Association in securing better hunting privileges and conditions for bow hunters; to cooperate with all conservation organizations in the conservation of game; to maintain a field course and conduct field tournaments and games in accordance with the rules of the National Field Archery Association.

Article 3 - Membership

All persons living in Boise, Idaho, or having connections in this city or vicinity shall be eligible to membership in the Boise Bowmen, Inc., provided they meet qualifications prescribed by this Club and by the State Archery Association.

Article 4 - Rights

INTERESTS OF MEMBERS EQUAL - MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATES. - In such an association the rights and interests of all members shall be equal, and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than

any other member. Such an association shall not issue any capital stock, but shall issue membership certificates to each member thereof, which certificates can not be assigned so that the transferee thereof can by such transfer become a member of the association, except by resolution of the board of directors and under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe.

Article 5 - Existance

The term of this existance shall be perpetual.

Article 6 - Location

The location of the principal office of the corporation is Boise, Ada County, Idaho.
