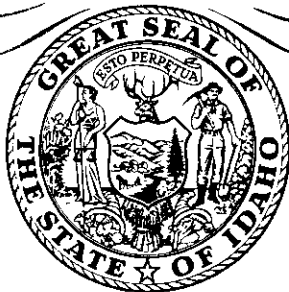

### CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

I, ARNOLD WILLIAMS, Secretary of State of the State of Idaho, and legal custodian of the corporation records of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify that the original of the articles of incorporation of

**FREEDOM EDUCATION SERVICE, INC.**

was filed in the office of the Secretary of State on the **Fifth** day  
of **September,** A. D. One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-one** and  
is duly recorded on Film No. **114** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State  
of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103 and  
Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and  
successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for  
**perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at  
**Kellogg** in the County of **Shoshone**  
and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Coopera-  
tive Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
FREEDOM EDUCATION SERVICE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENT: That we, the under-  
signed, all of whom are natural persons of legal age and citizens of the  
United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves  
together for the purpose of incorporating a non-profit cooperative  
association under the provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 30, Idaho Code,  
and we hereby certify in writing:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be:

FREEDOM EDUCATION SERVICE, INC.

ARTICLE II

The principal objective of this corporation is education within  
the meaning of Section 501 (c) (3) of the United States Internal Revenue  
Code of 1954 and has as its educational purposes, the following:

(a) To encourage and seek to instill by educational means and  
methods a broad and true understanding of the history of the United States  
of America.

(b) To encourage a broader and earlier teaching in our educational  
institutions of the economic principles of the American free enterprise system.

(c) To instruct by classes, seminars and public speeches in the  
history of the United States, the Constitution of the United States and in  
the fundamental concepts of liberty and free enterprise as established by  
the founding fathers of this nation.

(d) To conduct, promote, or provide for research in the nature of the threat of world communism and related subjects.

(e) To instruct, by classes, seminars, and public speeches in the history, nature, causes and programs of world communism and the inherent danger it presents to all freedom loving people.

(f) To promote a wider understanding of the world communist threat and related subjects through the publication and dissemination of the results of research.

(g) To establish an appropriate library and research files on the subjects above set forth available to students, research scholars and the general public.

### ARTICLE III

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation in the State of Idaho is: Kellogg, Shoshone County, Idaho.

### ARTICLE IV

The duration of said corporation is perpetual.

### ARTICLE V

The number of directors of said corporation shall not be less than five (5) nor more than seven (7) in number.
