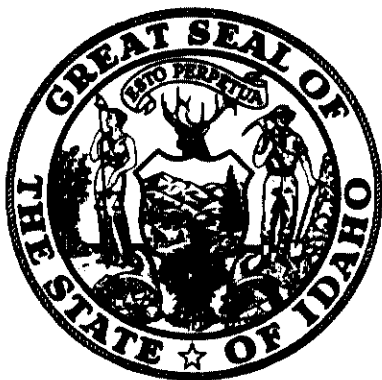
**CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

PINE CREEK, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Pine Creek, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The corporation shall have authority to issue 25,000 shares of common stock, all of one class, with a par value of Ten Dollars (\$10) per share.

FIFTH: The address of the corporation's initial registered office is P. O. Box 70, Terreton, Idaho 83450. The name of the initial registered agent at such address is William R. Hill.
