## THE PRIEST LAKE SENIOR CITIZENS CENTER

The Priest Lake Senior Citizens Center is formed to provide services to enhance the quality of life for disabled, handicapped, and senior citizens. These services include:

1. A facility to meet for social interaction through activities such as pot luck lunches or dinners, movies, games, special programs, etc.

2. A library of family oriented books, tapes, and old time movies available for use at the Senior Center or check out for personal use. The Senior Center library will be coordinated with the Priest Lake Library to add the books and tapes to the Priest Lake Library data base.

3. A food bank which will operate as an extension of the food bank operated by the Priest Lake Community Church to provide a collection and distribution center..

4. A facility which will be available to the community for gatherings of families or other groups.
