

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

BOON CREEK IRRIGATION COMPANY.

Art 1. Name.

The name of this corporation shall be Boone Creek Irrigation Company.

Art. 2. Purpose.

The purpose of this corporation shall be as follows:
Where as the stockholders are owners of certain rights to the use of the waters of Snake river, McTucker Springs, Halls springs, and Boone Creek, the purpose shall be to construct maintain and operate dams diverting works, canal, ditches, etc; to appoint watermasters, committees' agents, and to do and perform ever act and thing necessary to the proper use and enjoyment of their said water rights.

Art. 3. Place of business.

The place of the principle business of this corporation shall be Sterling, Bingham County, Idaho.

Art. 4. Term of existence.

The term of existence shall be fifty years.

Art. 5. Number of directors.

The number of directors shall be five.

Art. 6. Capital stock.

The amount of its capital stock shall be ten thousand four hundred and fifty dollars, divided into 2090 shares of the par value of \$5.00 each.

Art. 7.

The capital stock of this corporation shall consist of the rights of the stockholders to the use of the waters aforesaid, each inch of which is estimated to be of the value of five dollars.
