

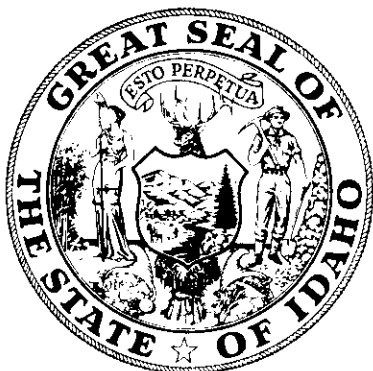

APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF AUTHORITY

To the Secretary of State of Idaho

Pursuant to Section 30-1-110, **Idaho Code**, the undersigned Corporation hereby applies for a Certificate of Authority to transact business in your State, and for that purpose submits the following statement:

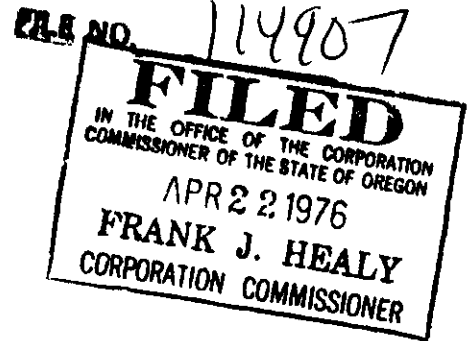

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
DENTAL REGISTRY, INC.



The undersigned natural person of the age of twenty-one (21) years or more, acting as incorporator under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, adopted the following Article of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME AND DURATION

The name of the corporation is DENTAL REGISTRY, INC. and its duration shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSES

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(a) To enable those organizations that market dental plans to provide their clientele with group dental practice with the resulting economies to their clientele and to enable dentists engaged in private practice to feasibly serve such group clientele. Accordingly, this corporation will furnish the administrative services to accomplish the foregoing, including the selection of competent dentists located to serve the clientele and with such skills and specialties as are required therefor, to review the work product of such dentists and to maintain a high level of professional competence among them, to assist dental coverage organizations in marketing group practice plans, to negotiate the contractual relations necessary to enable the clientele to avail itself to the group practice, and to administer the funds collected by the organization dealing with the clientele and destined for the dentist in accordance with the appropriate plans; provided, however,

that in no event shall this corporation engage in the sale, underwriting, or brokering of insurance or any activity requiring a license to engage therein by the Insurance Commissioner of the State of Oregon or any other state in which this corporation may engage in business and provided, further, that this corporation shall not engage in any activity that may be construed to be the practice of dentistry under the laws of the State of Oregon or any other such state.

(b) To have and to exercise all powers necessary and convenient to effect any and all of the purposes for which the corporation is organized.

(c) The foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers and as in furtherance of, and not limitation of, the general powers conferred by the State of Oregon; it is hereby expressly provided that the foregoing enumeration of specific powers should not be held to limit or restrict the power of this corporation; that the corporation may engage in any lawful activity which corporations may be organized under the Oregon Business Corporation Act, as amended.

ARTICLE III

CAPITAL STOCK

The number of shares which this corporation has authority to issue is 500 shares of no par value common stock.

ARTICLE IV

REGISTERED AGENT AND ADDRESS

The address of the initial registered office of this corporation is 1100 Yeon Building, Portland, Oregon, and the name of its initial Registered Agent at such address is Richard J. Brownstein.

ARTICLE V

DIRECTORS

The number of Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors of the corporation is two. The name and
