
HURLESS - SKEEM FLYING SERVICE, INC.

One Thousand Nine Hundred **Sixty-four** and duly recorded on Film No. **127** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Jerome** in the County of **Jerome.**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HURLESS - SKEEM FLYING SERVICE, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all being of full age and citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho.

And we hereby certify in writing:

I

That the name of said corporation shall be "HURLESS - SKEEM
FLYING SERVICE, INC."

II

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(1) To engage in the business of crop dusting, planting of crops, fertilizing of crops, and weed control and eradication by the use of airplanes and related equipment, and all business connected with or incidental thereto.

(2) To carry for hire passengers or freight in airplanes, on special trips or as common carriers on regularly established routes; to maintain hangars or other buildings and facilities for the repair, over-hauling and testing of airplanes and related equipment and to engage in the distribution and sale of airplanes and related equipment; to give instructions and training in the art of flying and navigation.

(3) To deal in all types of insecticides, fertilizers, and seed, both on its own account and as agent for other persons or corporations.

(4) To buy, sale, own, lease, exchange and deal generally in all types and kinds of airplanes and related equipment and moter vehicles necessary or convenient in carrying on the business of the corporation.

(5) To manufacture, process, purchase, sell and generally to trade and deal in and with goods, wares, and merchandise of every kind, nature and description, and to engage and participate in any mercantile, industrial or trading business of any kind or character whatsoever.

1 (6) To purchase, lease, own, sell, mortgage, sub-lease, or
2 otherwise acquire or dispose of lands, buildings, easements or property, both
3 real and personal, including all types and kinds of equipment which are
4 requisite for or are capable of being conveniently used in connection with any
5 of the objects of this corporation, and to enter into, make, perform, and
6 carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, and to acquire
7 and take over the good will, property, right, liabilities of any person, firm,
8 or corporations, either wholly or in part, and to pay for the same in cash,
9 stocks, or bonds of the corporation or otherwise.

10 (7) To engage in any and all other business of a commercial
11 nature which may be conveniently operated in connection with or incidental to
12 the corporate purposes expressed in the foregoing paragraphs.

13 (8) To purchase or acquire property, business rights or franchises
14 or for any other object in or about its business affairs, to incur debt and to
15 borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner, including the
16 issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, debentures, notes or other
17 evidence of indebtedness, and to acquire by purchase, gift, or otherwise,
18 shares of its own corporate stock and cancel the same or any part thereof,
19 or hold all or any of such stock for resale as treasury stock, or for the
20 purpose of making stock dividends to its shareholders, and to restrict the
21 transferability of its outstanding shares to the extent reasonably necessary to
22 protect the rights of the corporation and its shareholders in any stock purchase,
23 contracts, or options that may be made between themselves or any of them.

24 (9) To act as surety or creditor in any and all types of engagement,
25 including the power to execute, endorse and deliver contracts and to guarantee
26 the prompt and faithful performance for payment of debts, notes, agreements,
27 contracts and undertakings of any other person, firm, partnership, or cor-
28 poration, and to act as accommodation co-maker or guarantor on obligations
29 either as primary or secondary obligor.

30 (10) Without in any manner limiting any of the objects, purposes
31 or powers of the corporation, the business or purposes of said corporation
32 shall be from time to time to do any one or more of all of the acts or things
herein set forth.

(11) The several subdivisions contained in this paragraph of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers conferred on business corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho, all of which powers are hereby expressly claimed.

III

That in the event an election is in effect in any taxable year under the Technical Amendment Act of 1958, to have the income of this corporation taxed directly to its stockholders then the income for such taxable year must be distributed to its stockholders unless they all agree to accumulate the earnings.

IV

That the corporation shall have perpetual existence.

V

That the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho shall be located in Jerome in the County of Jerome, and that the post-office address of the registered office of said corporation in the State of Idaho is Jerome, Idaho.

VI

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00) divided into Ten Thousand (10,000) shares of a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) each, and that the total authorized number of shares shall be Ten Thousand (10,000) and their aggregate par value Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00). Fully paid shares of the stock of the corporation shall not be subject to assessment.

VII

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation which has been actually subscribed is Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) and that the following are the names and post office addresses of each of the incorporators and the number of shares subscribed by each:
