ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

HONEYSUCKLE HILLS OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC.

AN IDAHO CORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, the undersigned citizens of the United States of legal age, have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association under the laws of the State of Idaho, pursuant to Chapter 30, Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code, with all the rights, powers and privileges incident thereto and for that purpose enter into and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I.

NAME: The name of this corporation shall be "HONEYSUCKLE HILLS
OWNERS ASSOCIATION, INC."

ARTICLE II.

DURATION: The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

ADDRESS: The location and post office address of the registered office

Hayden Lake,
of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Clarkhouse/Kootenai County,
Idaho.

ARTICLE IV.

PURPOSES: The objects and purposes for which this corporation is organized, are as follows:

To acquire, own, hold, and manage real property for the exclusive use and benefit of its members and their guests, or for the common use and benefit of its members, their guests and the owners and occupants of lots in Hayden Lake Honeysuckle Hills Building Sites, Blocks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5, Kootenai County, Idaho, according to the duly recorded plats thereof; to own, acquire, construct, build, install, maintain, improve and manage, either by itself or in

association with others, buildings, facilities, equipment, installations and improvements of any and every nature and description, for the use, benefit or welfare of its members and their guests; to provide such goods, benefits and services to its members as can be provided to them to better advantage if undertaken in a collective rather than an individual basis; to possess all powers granted by law to an Idaho non-profit corporation, and to do any and all other things necessary or convenient for the full enjoyment and carrying out of the purposes aforesaid.

ARTICLE V.

POWERS: This corporation shall have and possess all powers granted corporations under the laws of the State of Idaho, and amendments thereto, and those powers necessary to effectuate its purposes or any of the same, and shall be subject to the restrictions imposed by law on corporations.

ARTICLE VI.

CHARACTER OF CORPORATION: This corporation shall be and remain a cooperative association with pecuniary profit not an object thereof and is organized and shall exist under the provisions of Chapter 30, Sections 30-1001 to 30-1005, inclusive, Idaho Code, and related statutes of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VII.

CAPITAL STOCK: This corporation is not organized for pecuniary profit and has no capital stock.

ARTICLE VIII.

MEMBERSHIP: Membership in this corporation will consist of the signatories to these articles and such persons as may from time to time be elected to membership in the corporation by the affirmative vote of a majority of the board and in compliance with the requirements of the By-Laws. A certificate of membership shall be issued to each member thereof, which certificate cannot be assigned so that the transferee can by such transfer become a member of the corporation, except upon resolution of the board of

directors and under such regulations as the By-Laws may prescribe. The By-Laws of this corporation shall provide qualifications of members and the terms and conditions of admission.

ARTICLE IX.

INTEREST OF MEMBERS: No member shall individually have or acquire any right, title or interest in any of the earnings or accumulations of the corporation or its property. In the event of the dissolution of this corporation any property remaining after the payment of debts and costs of dissolution shall be donated to a charitable institution or public use by the directors.

The rights and interest of all members shall be equal and each shall have equal voice and right at all meetings of members and the right to equal privileges upon payment of uniform dues or charges as fixed by the directors under the By-Laws for the use and benefit of the various property, facilities and services provided by the corporation.

ARTICLE X.

MANAGEMENT: That the affairs of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a Board of Directors consisting of not less than five (5) persons to be elected from among the members in accordance with the provisions of the By-Laws at the annual meeting of the membership, which shall be held on the first Friday in May of each year, and such directors shall serve until their successors are elected and qualified. Until the first annual meeting v and until their successors are elected and qualified, the following persons shall constitute the Board of Directors:
