A Nonprofit Corporation SECRETALY OF STATE STATE

Purpose:

The corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Membership:

In accordance with Title 30, Chapter 3: Section 34 and Section 36 -Membership should be defend in the By -Laws of the corporation. (The Corporation will have members.)
