ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

IDAHO DERMATOLOGY SOCIETY, INC.

This amendment was adopted June 5th 1990.

A quorum was present at the meeting held to pass the amendment and a majority of the membership voted in favor of the amendment.

AMENDING ARTICLE I., SECTION 2., to read as follows:

SECTION 2. This corporation shall be a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Idaho for non-profit corporation as set forth in Title 30, Chapter 3.

This organization is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law, or (b) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 for the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Upon the winding up and dissolution of this corporation, after paying or adequately providing for the debts and obligations of the corporation, the remaining assets shall be distributed to a nonprofit fund, foundation, or corporation which is organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious and/or scientific purposes and which has established its tax exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.
