The undersigned natural person of the age of eighteen years or more, licensed by the State of Idaho to perform Physical Therapy services, acting as an incorporator under the Idaho Professional Services Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is : "Idaho Children's Academy and Therapy Center, P. C.."

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which the Corporation is organized is the providing of physical therapy services by a licensed physical therapist.

ARTICLE III

The aggregate number of shares which the Corporation shall have authority to issue is One Hundred (100) shares, without par value, of voting common stock which may only be issued to licensed physical therapists.

ARTICLE IV

ARTICLE V

Only persons licensed to provide physical therapy services may serve a directors of this corporation. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors is 1, and the name and address of the person who is to serve as director until the first annual meeting of the shareholders, or until her successor has been elected and qualified, is:

ARTICLE VI

No shareholder has any preemptive or preferential right to subscribe to or otherwise acquire any shares of stock of the Corporation, or any obligations or securities converted into or carrying options or warrants to purchase shares of stock of the Corporation, whether now or hereafter authorized and whether unissued or held by the Corporation as treasury stock (whether or not the issuance or sale of any such shares, obligations, or securities would adversely effect such shareholder's proportionate voting power) other than such rights, if any, as the Board of Directors in its discretion from time to time may grant, and at such price as the Board of Directors may fix.

ARTICLE VII

The Corporation shall indemnify to the fullest extent permitted by the Idaho Business Corporation Act, any person who has been made, or is threatened to be made, a party to an action, suit, or proceeding, whether civil, criminal, administrative, investigative, or otherwise (including an action, suit or proceeding by or in the right of the Corporation), by reason of the fact that the person is or was a director or officer of the Corporation, or a fiduciary within the meaning of the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 with respect to an employee benefit plan of the Corporation, or serves or served at the request of the Corporation as a director, or as an officer, or as a fiduciary of an employee benefit plan of another corporation, partnership, joint venture, trust, or other enterprise. Nothing in this Article shall limit the personal liability of any licenced physical therapist who provides physical therapy services as an officer, shareholder, agent or employee of this corporation for negligent or wrongful acts or misconduct committed by the therapist or by any person under the therapist's direct control, while providing physical therapy services on behalf of the corporation.
