## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## BUSY BODY'S, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation Act, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation.

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Busy Body's, Inc.

SECOND: The period of its duration is perpetual.

THIRD: The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH: The aggregate number of shares which the corporation shall have authority to issue is one thousand shares, with \$5.00 par value, and all shares of the capital stock of this corporation shall be known as common stock, with each share of stock to be entitled to one vote.

FIFTH: The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is P.O. Box 892, Route 3, Box 3692, Nampa, Idaho 83653-0892, and the name of its initial registered agent at such address is Jackie Moffis.
