PROVISIONS OF THE CONSTITUTION OF STATE OF IDAHO.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company hereby constitutes and appoints F. W. Kettenbach, a resident and citizen of the state of Idaho, residing at Lewiston, Nez Perce county, Idaho, as the person upon whom process issued by authority of, or under any law of the state of Idaho, may be served, and does hereby designate the county of Nez Perce, in the state of Idaho, as the county in which the principal place of business of this corporation is to be conducted in the state of Idaho, and does hereby designate Lewiston, in the county of Nez Perce, in the state of Idaho, as the city in which the principal place of business is to be conducted in the state of Idaho.

And the said Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company hereby accepts the provisions of the Constitution of the state of Idaho.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the said Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation Company has caused these presents to be executed on its behalf, by its president and secretary thereunto duly authorized by a resolution of the board of directors, this 25th day of November, A.D. 1910.


