ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BLUE LAKES TROUT FARM, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of full age and are citizens of the United States and are bona fide residents and citizens of the State of Idaho have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

Ι.

That the name of the said corporation shall be "BLUE LAKES TROUT FARM. INC."

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

- 1. To conduct and carry on the business of propagating, growing, dressing, curing, preserving, smoking, canning, packing, storing, marketing, buying, selling and generally dealing in all kinds of fish and fish eggs, fish parts, fish products, fresh and salt water sea foods and other foods, meats or food products, whether at wholesale, retail or otherwise, or through jobbers, distributors, consumers or users.
- 2. To purchase or otherwise acquire, own, hold, sell, improve, lease, mortgage, use, utilize and operate either real estate or any interest therein within the State of Idaho or within any of the several states of the United States and to erect, manage, care for, maintain, extend, alter, use and operate raceways, dwelling houses, warehouses, packing houses, storage plants, buildings, ditches, canals, wells, fences and other improvements thereon and to purchase and otherwise acquire, own, hold, lease, mortgage, sell and otherwise dispose of, hire, use and operate such machinery, equipment, motor vehicles or other personal property as may be necessary or convenient for the transaction of its business or to carry out the purposes for which this corporation is formed.
- 3. To borrow and lend money and negotiate loans, draw acceptances, make, issue, draw, endorse, discount, buy and sell conditional sales contracts, bills of exchange, promissory notes, bonds, debentures, coupons and other negotiable instruments, securities, mortgages and pledge agreements; to issue, subscribe for, take, acquire and hold, sell, exchange and deal in shares of capital stock,

including the capital stock issued by it, and bonds, obligations and securities of any government or authority or company; to give any guaranty for the payment of money or performance of any obligation or undertaking incidental or appropriate for the carrying on generally of its business; to enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind with any person, firm, association or corporation, private, public or municipal or body politic and with the Government of the United States or any state, territory or colony thereof or any foreign country; to make charitable and business donations or gifts.

- 4. To create, purchase, own, hold, sell and otherwise acquire or exchange patent rights and inventions and designs with the right to issue licenses for the same and receive pay therefor.
- 5. To employ executives, managers, bookkeepers, salesmen, clerical assistants and any and all employees that may be necessary or convenient to the proper carrying on of its business and in carrying on its business or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects to do any and all things which a co-partnership or natural person could do and exercise and which is now or hereafter may be authorized by law.
- 6. To exercise, use and employ the authority specified in Section 30-114 Idaho Code 1947, and to have, exercise, use and employ any or all of the same and any or all of the objects, purposes, powers, privileges, authority and rights therein and herein set forth, both within and without the State of Idaho and within the United States of America, District of Columbia, the territories and colonies of the United States and in foreign countries, and to have one or more corporate or business offices and places of business within and without said State, said United States of America, District of Columbia, territories and colonies of the United States and in foreign countries.

The statements contained in the several subdivisions numbered 1 to 6 of this paragraph shall, except where otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other subdivision but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers. The several subdivisions contained in this statement of purposes shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrict in any manner the

general powers conferred on this type of corporation by the laws of the State of Idaho, all of which are hereby expressly claimed.

III.

That the principal place of business, registered office and the location and post office address of the registered office of said corporation shall be Twin Falls, County of Twin Falls, State of Idaho.

IV.

That subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law, the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

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That the number of Directors of said corporation shall be not less than three (3) nor more than five (5), which number of Directors shall be fixed by the By-Laws of the corporation.

VI.

That the amount of capital stock of said corporation shall be Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) divided into Fifty Thousand (50,000) shares of the par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) each.

VII.

That the amount of the capital stock of said corporation which has been actually subscribed is Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00), and the following are the names of the subscribers with their addresses and the number and par value of the shares subscribed by each:
