signed, at least one of whom is a bone fide resident of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

That the name of said corporation shall be Corner Cigar Store.

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are: to buy, sell, mortgage, export, import and deal in tobacce, cigars, cigarets, confectioneries of all kinds, soft drinks, newspapers, magazines, stationery, books, sporting goods and other merchandise of all classes and descriptions.

To engage in general retail and wholesale business of tobaccomists, confectioners, stationers, book sellers and general retail and wholesale merchandising business.

To buy, own, sell, lease, mortgage and bond real estate and personal property of every character and nature. To issue bonds or other securities for the purpose of purchasing, constructing, maintaining, operating or improving any of the properties of this corporation and to acquire, own and hold such real and personal property as may be necessary or convenient for the transaction of business.

In the purchase or acquisition of property and its improvement, business rights or franchises or leases, and for additional working capital or for any other object in or about its business or affairs, to incur acht, and to raise, borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner including the issue and sale or other disposition of bonds, obligations, negotiable and transferable instruments and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge, dead of trust or otherwise.
