ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned persons, all of whom are of full age and two-thirds of whom are citizens of the United States of America, do associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a general business corporation under the laws and statutes of the State of Idaho, and in compliance with Title 30, Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE FIRST

NAME

The name of this corporation is

and shall be DAIRY SNOW PRODUCTS, INC.

ARTICLE SECOND

PURPOSES

The purpose of this corporation shall be specifically to acquire through lease or franchise the right to use trademarks, tradenames, designs for plants, plant facilities and equipment, together with management agreements and to acquire plant facilities and to engage generally in the manufacturing and marketing, either for wholesale or for retail, all and every kind of dairy products or dairy confections.

That although the above are the specific purposes for which this corporation shall have been formed, this corporation shall have full power and authority to buy, sell, deal in and engage in the sale of any and all types and kinds of real or l-v

Smith 1900 Main Street Boise, Idaho personal property and to carry on any kind of business or business activity which a natural person could or might do except such specific businesses which are prohibited from being carried on by a corporation under the laws and statutes of the State of Idaho.

That in order to accomplish its objects and purposes this corporation shall have full power and authority to buy and sell all kinds of real or personal property and facilities, to enter into any and all kinds of leasing agreements, franchise agreements, marketing agreements and agreements for plans and specifications for manufacturing facilities and factories, to borrow money and to mortgage, pledge or hypothecate any and all of its real and personal property as security for the payment of such loan and to issue its own stock.

This corporation shall have specific authority to issue in its own name debentures to finance its activities in addition to the general power to borrow money, such debentures to be in such form and under such terms and conditions as the Board of Directors may from time to time prescribe.

ARTICLE THIRD

DURATION

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, but nothing herein contained shall prevent a sooner winding up of the business of said corporation by voluntary act as provided for under the laws and statutes of the State of Idaho relating to general business corporations.

ARTICLE FOURTH

LOCATION AND POST OFFICE ADDRESS

The location and post office address of this corporation in

the State of Idaho shall be as follows: 1900 Main Street, Boise, Ada County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE FIFTH

SHARES OF STOCK

The total authorized capital

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stock shall be \$50,000.00, divided into 5,000,000 Common Shares, each having a par or nominal value of One Cent $(l\phi)$ per share. Each share shall have equal voting rights, preferences and restrictions granted to or imposed upon other shares.

ARTICLE SIXTH

ARTICLE SEVENTH

MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATION

The management of the

corporation shall be vested

in a Board of not less than three nor more than nine directors who shall be elected by the stockholders at the annual meeting of the stockholders.

The Board of Directors shall convene at least once a year immediately following their election to office, but may from time to time assemble for special meetings, either with, or without notice, either within or without the State of Idaho, as meetings of the Board of Directors may be called into session by the President of said corporation; provided, however, that in the event that the same be without notice, the written consent of its directors shall be required to hold such meeting.

Nothing in these articles of incorporation shall require any director or officer to be a stockholder in said corporation.

At all meetings of the Board of Directors a majority vote shall be required to pass any official act for the corporation except wherein a different requirement is imposed by the statutes of the State of Idaho.

At the first annual meeting of the Board of Directors said 3-v

The offices of this corporation shall be as follows: President, Vice President and Secretary-Treasurer, but nothing herein contained shall prevent the Board itself from dividing the office of Secretary-Treasurer into two offices or to create additional offices of this corporation.

ARTICLE EIGHTH

TEMPORARY OFFICERS
AND DIRECTORS

Until the first annual meeting of this corporation,

the officers and directors of this corporation shall be as follows: M. D. Piepgrass, President and Director; Henry D. Scott, Vice President and Director; Edith G. Stephens, Secretary-Treasurer and Director.

ARTICLE NINTH

ANNUAL MEETING OF STOCKHOLDERS

The annual meeting of the stockholders of this

corporation shall be held on the second Tuesday in January of each year, commencing with the year 1965; provided, however, in the event that the second Tuesday of January of any year shall fall upon any legal holiday, then said annual meeting of said stockholders shall be held on the next business day.

At each annual meeting of the stockholders, such stockholders, in addition to any other business to be transacted at such meeting, shall elect directors to serve for the ensuing year; provided, however, that nothing herein contained shall prevent the stockholders or directors from increasing or decreasing the number of directors, as provided in the By-Laws or the laws and statutes of the State of Idaho, except within the limitations set forth in Article Seventh hereof.

ARTICLE ELEVENTH

BY-LAWS

Within thirty (30) days next

Smith 1900 Main Street Boise, Idaho following the filing of these articles of incorporation, the stockholders and directors shall adopt a code of By-Laws for its government, which shall not be inconsistent with the laws and statutes of the State of Idaho.

The By-Laws of this corporation may be amended or repealed, or any By-Law may be adopted at any annual or special meeting of the stockholders or any regular or special meeting of the directors; provided, however, that such call for such meeting to adopt, repeal or to amend the By-Laws states such purposes. The amendment of By-Laws may be by a majority vote.
