ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Of

IDAHO COUNTY LIGHT & POWER COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION, INC.

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We, the undersigned Frank H. Arnzen and M. A. Pierce, respectively the President and Secretary of Idaho County Light & Power Cooperative Association, Inc., a corporation organized under and pursuant tothe provisions of Chapter 10 of Title 29, Idaho Code Annotated, 1932, and all laws amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto, do hereby certify that at a special meeting of the members of said Corporation held at the office of Wilbur L. Campbell in the City of Grangeville, County of Idaho, State of Idaho, on the 28th day of July, 1938, pursuant to waiver of notice of all the 13 members of the time, place and specific purpose thereof, at which 14 meeting all of the members were present, the following resolutions

were unanimously adopted: RESOLVED, that section 4 of article 5 of the articles of incorporation of Idaho County Light & Power Cooperative Association, Inc., be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Each member shall be entitled to one "Section 4. vote and no more upon each matter submitted to a vote at a meeting of the members. At all meetings of the members at which a quorum is present all questions shall be decided by a vote of a majority of the members present in person or represented by proxy, except as otherwise provided by law, the articles of incorporation, or these by-laws. The election of directors shall be by ballot and each member shall have the right to cast as many votes as there are directors to be elected at such election, and each member may cast the whole number of his or its votes either in person or by proxy for one candidate or he or it may distribute his or its votes among as many candidates as he or The number of candidates equal to the it shall see fit. number of directors to be elected receiving the highest number of votes shall be elected for the term specified in the by-laws of the Corporation.

RESOLVED, that article 5 of the articles of incorporation of Idaho County Light and Power Cooperative Association, Inc., be and the same is hereby further

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amended by adding two new sections thereto to read as follows:

"Section 6. At regular annual meetings of the members of the Cooperative at least ten per centum (10%) of the total number of members of the Cooperative present in person shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at all meetings of the members so long as the number of members does not exceed one hundred (100), then, and in such case, the members present either in person or represented by proxy at such meetings of the members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at such meetings.

"Section 7. At all special meetings of the members at least 10 per centum (10%) of the total number of members of the Cooperative present in person shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at such meetings."

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the President and Secretary of the Cooperative be and they hereby are authorized and directed to make, execute and acknowledge articles of amendment embracing the foregoing resolutions, and to cause such articles to be filed for record in the manner required by law.
