ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LACKEY BROS., INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are of full age and citizens of the United States of America, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves and do hereby and by these Articles of Incorporation, unite and associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho for the purposes hereinafter stated.

I.

The name of this corporation shall be LACKEY BROS., INC.

II.

The term for which this corporation shall exist shall be in perpetuity.

III.

The location and post office address of the registered office of this corporation in the State of Idaho shall be Nampa, Canyon County, Idaho.

IV.

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed shall be and are:

- (a) To carry on the business of buying and selling, training, raising and breeding of horses.
- (b) To enter into, make and perform and carry out contracts of every kind and character with any person, firm, association or corporation.
- (c) To perform services of every kind and nature authorized by law for any person, firm, association or corporation.
- (d) To acquire the good will, rights, and property of any person, firm, association or corporation, and to pay for the same in cash, stocks, notes or bonds of this corporation, or otherwise.
- (e) To purchase, own, lease, hold, improve, sell and convey such real estate, and to construct, lease and maintain thereon such buildings or other improvements as shall be necessary or proper for conducting the business of this corporation, either within or without the State of Idaho, and to buy, own, lease, improve, sell or convey such other real estate as shall be acquired by this corporation in the conduct of its business.
- (f) To purchase, own, hold, vote, sell or hypothecate the stocks and bonds of other corporations, and to take in the name of this corporation such stocks, bonds, mortgages, notes, deeds, conveyances or other evidence of indebtedness, ownership, title or security as may be acquired by this corporation in the usual and ordinary transaction of its business.

(g) To borrow money in the name of this corporation in such amounts as the stockholders or directors may determine, and issue as evidence thereof notes, bonds, or other evidence of indebtedness of this corporation, and to secure the payment of the same, when required, by mortgages, trust deeds, pledges, assignments, or other conveyances of all or any portion of its property, real or personal.

(h) To obtain licenses for, carry on and promote any other business whatsoever which may seem to the officers or stockholders or directors of this corporation capable of being carried on in connection with the foregoing objects and purposes, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation or to enhance the value of its property,

(i) To carry out the objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed as principal, agent, or otherwise, to the same extent as natural persons might do.

(k) It is the intention of the incorporators of this company that the foregoing clauses shall be construed both as objects and powers, and the foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be construed to limit or restrict in any manner the powers of the corporation, but that said corporation shall have the power to do all and everything necessary, suitable, convenient or proper for the accomplishment of any of its purposes, or the attainment of any one or more of the objects herein enumerated or incidental to the powers herein named, or which shall at any time appear conducive or expedient for the protection or benefit of the corporation, and this to the same extent and as fully as natural persons might or could do.

The business of this corporation shall be managed and conducted by a Board of Directors of such number as may be set forth by the By-Laws, the first board to consist of four (4) members to be selected at a meeting of the stockholders.
