ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

TEWS ANGUS FARMS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we, the undersigned, LAURA S. TEWS, GERALD TEWS and NANCY TEWS, all being natural persons of full legal age, and citizens of the United States of America, do hereby associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the Business Corporation Act and the general incorporation laws of the State of Idaho, and for said purpose do hereby certify and adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be TEWS ANGUS FARMS, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is organized are as follows: To maintain and operate a general farming, ranching and livestock business including the growing, buying and selling of all types of farm products and livestock and breeding of livestock; to receive, acquire, hold, purchase, dispose of, convey, mortgage and/or lease real and personal property and to dispose of, sell, lease, assign, transfer, mortgage and/or convey any rights, privileges, franchises, real or personal property of this corporation, and to acquire, purchase, guaranty, hold, mortgage, own, vote, sell, pledge, and/or otherwise dispose of and deal in shares, bonds, securities and debentures and other evidences of indebtedness of other corporations, domestic or foreign; to conduct business in the State of Idaho, other states, District of Columbia, territories and colonies of the United States and foreign countries, and to have one or more offices and places of business out of this state, and to acquire, receive, hold, purchase, lease, mortgage, dispose of and/or convey real and personal

property situated out of this State; to enter into, make, perform, and carry out contracts of every kind and for any lawful purpose, without limit as to amount, with any person, firm, association, corporation, municipality, State or Government, or any subdivision, district or department thereof; to buy, sell, maintain and operate all necessary real and personal property and all equipment, machinery, furnishings, and fixtures in order to transact said business; to borrow and lend money and to make and receive notes, bonds and debentures of every kind and to secure the payment thereof by mortgage, pledge or otherwise upon all property of the corporation; to pay for in cash or stocks or bonds of this corporation the good will, rights, assets and property, and to undertake and assume the whole or any part of the liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation; to enter into any lawful arrangement for sharing profits, union of interest, reciprocal concession or co-operations, with any corporation, association, partnership, syndicate, entity, person or government, and to carry on any business or transaction deemed necessary, convenient or incidental to carrying on any of the purposes of this corporation; the several clauses contained in this paragraph shall be construed as both purposes and powers, and shall be in no wise limiting or restricting by reference to or by inference from the terms of any other clause, but shall be regarded as independent purposes and powers; and no recitation, expression or declaration of specific or special powers or purposes shall be deemed to be exclusive, but it is expressly declared that all other lawful powers not inconsistent herewith are herewith included; and all powers and purposes named herein shall not be deemed a limitation of general powers contained and granted under the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE III

The corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE IV

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation shall be Route #1, Filer, Twin Falls County, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V

The capital stock of the corporation shall be One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) to consist of One Thousand (1,000) shares of common stock of the par value of One Hundred Dollars (\$100) each. Said stock shall be non-assessable.

ARTICLE VI

That the number of directors of the corporation shall be three.

ARTICLE VII

That the name and post office address of each of the incorporators, and the number of shares of stock subscribed by each are as follows:
