ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CALVARY ASSEMBLY, INC.

We, the undersigned natural persons, all of whom are residents of the State of Idaho, having this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a religious corporation under the provision of Chapter II, Title 30, Idaho Code, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The Name of this Corporation is Calvary Assembly, Inc.

ARTICLE II.

The duration of this Corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III.

This Corporation is not organized for profit; nor may it issue stock nor declare nor distribute dividends, and no part of its net income shall inure to the benefit of its Directors, Officers, or Members.

The estimated value of the property of this Corporation, at the time of making these Articles of Incorporation is \$0.00.

ARTICLE IV.

The Principal Place of Business of this Corporation shall be located at the corner of Truck Lane and Poplar Street, in the City of Buhl, County of Twin Falls, and State of Idaho.

ARTICLE V.

The Purpose or Purposes for which this Corporation shall exist are:

1. To establish and maintain a local place of Worship of Almighty God, our Heavenly Father, and the Lord Jesus Christ, His only begotten Son, through the Holy Spirit, and for the promotion of Christian Fellowship and Teaching of the Holy Scriptures, within and without the United States of America.
2. To establish and maintain such departments as may be thought advisable for the pursuance of its work.
3. This Corporation shall have and possess, exercise and enjoy, all the powers and authority generally conferred upon Non-Profit Religious Corporations, by the laws of the State of Idaho.

ARTICLE VI.

The Board of Directors of this Corporation shall consist of not less than five (5), which number shall be governed by the by-laws.

That such meeting, its purpose, time and place were set forth by posting of notice of such meeting in a conspicuous place on the building where held, and by Publication in the Buhl Herald on July 1, 1965, and on July 8, 1965, at least two weeks prior to Date of Meeting.

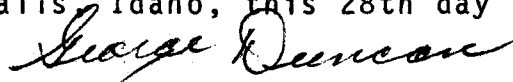
