ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
BINGHAM COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY INC.

NON-PROFIT COOPERATIVE ASSOCIATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned persons, at least five of whom are bona fide, full-age citizens of the United States, and other corporations, associations and copartnerships authorized by law to become members of such associations, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a non-profit cooperative association without capital stock, under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and that we do hereby make, acknowledge, publish, declare and certify the following to be our Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE ONE

The name of this corporation shall be BINGHAM COUNTY HISTORICAL SOCIETY, INC..

ARTICLE TWO

The objects and purposes for which this corporation is formed are as follows:

- (1) To ascertain, define, collect, record and preserve the history of the people, the organizations, the institutions, and the political sub-divisions and units within the geographical area known as Bingham County, Idaho, and each and every part thereof.
- (2) To acquire, support, maintain, and operate museums, libraries, exhibitions, and collections of all kinds of items and materials and information of historical interest.
- (3) To conduct, foster, promote, maintain, and operate historical restoration projects within Bingham County, Idaho.

(4) To mark, develop, preserve, restore, repair, maintain and supervise historical sites.

(5) To acquire, preserve, restore, repair, maintain and use all kinds of items, materials, and information of historical interest.

(6) To foster, sponsor, undertake and promote historical research and collection and accumulation of all kinds of items, materials and information of historical interest.

(7) To promote public interest in historical information and particularly that relating to Bingham County, Idaho, and use all lawful means of advertising and disseminating information with reference thereto.

(8) To sponsor and conduct programs, lectures, pageants, contests and other public affairs and to arrange for publication, ^{and} dissemination of historical information.

(9) To cooperate with all political, educational, civic and cultural organizations interested in any of the objects and purposes of this corporation.

(10) To utilize historical information, objects, materials and sites in Bingham County, Idaho, as attractions for tourists and visitors to this area as well as to local residents.

(11) To foster and develop among the people of Bingham County area a feeling of pride in the accomplishments of those who have settled and developed the area and its institutions and a desire to contribute substantially to the heritage to be passed on to succeeding generations.

(12) To assess members and campaign for funds and to receive gifts, donations, bequests, legacies and devises and funds and properties of all kinds and from all sources to carry out the objectives of this association and to comply with any and all

lawful conditions and restrictions which may be imposed for the receipt and use of the same.

(13) To invest said funds or to place them in trust as a reasonable investor would do his own, ^{funds} and to apply all income therefrom to the purposes of this association.

(14) To procure the services of trained historians, researchers and other personnel skilled in the objects of this association.

(15) To incur debt and to raise, borrow and secure the payment of money in any lawful manner.

(16) To purchase, hold, sell, develop, improve, lease and enjoy real estate; to erect, manage, care for, maintain, extend and alter buildings and improvements thereon; and to purchase, hold, use, sell and otherwise enjoy all other kinds of property.

(17) To do and have authority to do all acts and things necessary, suitable or proper in carrying on and accomplishing any of the objects and purposes herein expressed or implied or that may be incidental thereto and to make, perform and carry out contracts and agreements for any lawful purpose.

(18) To do each and everything that may be necessary to qualify and thereafter to continue qualified as a tax exempt corporation, under the tax laws of the United States of America and the State of Idaho.

(19) To pay and satisfy all expenses and liabilities that may be incurred in furthering the objects and purposes of this corporation.

(20) To do each and every thing, not expressly prohibited by law, and without limitation to the general powers, objects and purposes heretofore mentioned, to the same extent that natural persons might, or could do;

provided nothing shall be done for the purpose, directly or indirectly of fixing the price, or regulating the production, of any article of commerce or of produce of the soil, or of consumption by the people or for the pecuniary profit of any member as such.

ARTICLE THREE

The location and Post Office address of the registered office and principal place of business of said corporation shall be Blackfoot, in the County of Bingham, State of Idaho.

ARTICLE FOUR

That the duration of this corporation, shall be perpetual, unless dissolved by process of law.

ARTICLE FIVE

This corporation is a non-profit corporation, and shall have no capital stock, and no dividends, or pecuniary profits shall be declared to the members thereof.

ARTICLE SIX

The rights and interests of all members shall be equal and no member can have or acquire a greater interest therein than any other member and membership certificates shall be transferable only by resolutions of the Board of Directors under such regulations as the by-laws may prescribe. The number, qualification and election of members, the terms and conditions of admission, and classification and regulation of membership, the rights or other privileges of the classes of members, and the time, mode, conditions, and effect of expulsion or withdrawal from and of restoration to membership, fees for admission, assessments or dues to carry on the business of the association and reimbursement for services rendered and expenses incurred by the association for its members, and the time of payment and manner of collecting amounts due and for forfeiture of the interest of a member in the association for non-payment thereof, shall be

fixed and determined by the by-laws.

ARTICLE SEVEN

By-laws may be adopted, altered, amended, or repealed at any regular meeting of the members, or at any special meeting of the members of this association called for that purpose by the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members present at such meeting, provided that a quorum as specified in the by-laws of the association or the laws of the State of Idaho be present.

ARTICLE EIGHT

The business of this association shall be managed by a board of not less than three nor more than fifteen directors, the number, qualification, terms of office, manner of election, powers and duties of such directors shall be such as may be prescribed by law, these articles and such by-laws as may from time to time be in force.

ARTICLE NINE

Those members who attend any regular or special meeting of the membership of this association, officially and regularly called, shall constitute a quorum.

ARTICLE TEN
