## ARTICLES OF OF INCORPORATION BONNEVILLE LUMBER COMPANY

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age and are citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

I

That the name of this corporation shall be BONNEVILLE LUMBER COMPANY

II

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- 1. To buy, sell, manufacture and deal in lumber and wood products, cement, hardware, metal, gravel, sand, coal, paint, brick, wallpaper, electric appliances and machinery, tools, furniture, and in general, building supplies and equipment of every kind, nature and description.
- 2. To buy, sell, license, lease, deal in and deal with machinery of every kind and description and more particularly, agricultural machinery, farm machinery, dairy machinery, elevating, conveying and transmission machinery, or parts thereof.
- 3. To buy, sell, lease and deal in motors, automobiles, motor trucks, motor busses, airplanes and their appliances, fuels and accessories; to operate and maintain garages and to store, repair, rent and lease motors, automobiles, motor trucks, motor busses, airplanes and other vehicles.
- 4. To carry on and conduct a general contracting business including the designing, constructing and enlarging of houses, apartments and buildings of every kind, nature and description.
- 5. To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, maintain, work, develop, subdivide, sell, lease, exchange, hire, convey, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal in, lands and leaseholds and any interests, estate and rights in real property, and any personal or mixed property, and any franchises, rights, licenses or privileges necessary, convenient or appropriate for any of the purposes herein expressed.
- 6. To borrow money, and to make and issue bonds, notes, debentures, obligations and evidences of indebtedness of

all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, without limit as to amount, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and description.

7. To carry on any other lawful business whatsoever which may seem to the corporation capable of being carried on in connection with the above, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation or to enhance the valuation of its property.

III

Subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law, the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

IV

That the principal place of business, registered office and the location and postoffice address of the registered office of said corporation shall be Idaho Falls, in the County of Bonneville, State of Idaho.

V

The total authorized capital stock of this corporation shall be TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$250,000.00) DOLLARS, divided into Two Thousand Five Hundred (2,500) shares, of the par value of ONE HUNDRED AND NO/100 (\$100.00) DOLLARS each, and all of said stock shall be Common Stock.

VI

The number of directors of the corporation shall be not less than three (3) nor more than nine (9) and said number of directors may be altered from time to time as may be provided in the By-Laws. In case of any increase in the number of directors, the additional directors may be elected by the directors or by the stockholders at any annual or special meeting as shall be provided in the By-Laws.

VII

The Board of Directors shall have the power to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and adopt new By-Laws at any meeting of the Board of Directors. All By-Laws shall be subject to amendment, alteration and repeal by the stockholders at any annual meeting or at any special meeting called for such purposes.
