ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
J-B & F ADVERTISING CO., INC.

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KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age and are citizens of the United States, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

I

That the name of this corporation shall be
J-B & F ADVERTISING CO., INC.

II

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

1. To transact the business of advertising, promoting and developing the business of other corporations, partnerships or individuals for hire, or upon commission, or otherwise, by and through the means of preparing advertising for other corporations, partnerships or individuals, and of advertising the business, commodities, or other property, real, personal or mixed, of other corporations, partnerships or individuals in newspapers, books, booklets, prospectuses, magazines, circulars, pamphlets or other similar literature and advertising medium,
2. To carry on the business of stationers, printers, lithographers, stereotypers, electrotypers, photographic printers, photolithographers, engravers, die-sinkers, book-printers, account-book manufacturers, dealers in parchment, dealers in stamps, advertising agents, designers, draftsmen, ink manufacturers, booksellers, publishers, paper manufacturers, and dealers in the materials used in the manufacture of paper, and dealers in or manufacturers of any other articles or things of a character similar or analogous to the foregoing, or any of them, or connected therewith.'

3. To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, maintain, work, develop, sell, lease, exchange, hire, convey, mortgage, or otherwise dispose of and deal in, lands and leaseholds, and any interests, estate, and rights in real property, and any personal or mixed property, and any franchises, rights, licenses or privileges necessary, convenient or appropriate for any of the purposes herein expressed.

4. To borrow money, and to make and issue notes, bonds, debentures, obligations and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, without limit as to amount, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and description.

5. To carry on any other lawful business whatsoever which may seem to the corporation capable of being carried on in connection with the above, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation or to enhance the valuation of its property.

III

Subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law, the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

IV

That the principal place of business, registered office and the location and postoffice address of the registered office of said corporation shall be 340 May Street, Idaho Falls, Bonneville County, State of Idaho.

V

That the total authorized capital stock of said corporation shall be ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND AND NO/100 (\$100,000.00) DOLLARS, divided into One Hundred Thousand (100,000) shares of the par value of ONE AND NO/100 (\$1.00) DOLLARS each, and all of said stock shall be common stock.

VI

The number of directors of said corporation shall not be less than three (3) nor more than nine (9), as hereinafter fixed and determined by the By-Laws of the corporation.

VII

That the Board of Directors shall have the power to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and adopt new By-Laws at any meeting of the Board of Directors. All By-Laws shall be subject to amendment, alteration and repeal by the stockholders at any annual meeting or at any special meeting called for such purposes.

VIII
