

Articles of Incorporation of the Wood River Telegraph Company.

Know all men by these presents. that we, the undersigned have this day associated ourselves together for the purpose of incorporating under the laws of the Territory of Idaho, a corporation to be known by the corporate name of The Wood River Telegraph Company.

And we hereby certify that the objects for which this Corporation is formed are to construct maintain and operate a line of Telegraph between the several towns in Alturas County Idaho Territory and between said Towns and other Towns in said Territory and to engage generally in the business of transmitting telegraphic messages for hire over all lines owned or controlled by said Corporation and over lines of Telegraph owned or controlled by other Corporations or individuals, and for that purpose to exercise generally all powers usually incident to corporations maintaining and operating Telegraph lines.

That its principal place of business shall be in the Town of Bellevue

Allura County Idaho Territory

That the term of its existence shall be forty nine years from and after the date of its incorporation

That the number of its trustees shall be three and that the names of those who shall be trustees and serve as such officers the first three months and shall manage the concerns of the Corporation for that period, and until the election of their successors and their qualification are

That the capital stock of this Corporation shall be Fifteen Thousand (15000) dollars divided into Thirty Thousand shares of the par value of fifty cents each
