

Know all men by these Presents That
we the undersigned have this day
associated ourselves together for the
purpose of incorporating under the
laws of the Territory of Idaho, a
Corporation to be known by the cor-
porate name of the "Gold Belt
and Hailey Water Power Company".
And we hereby certify that the ob-
jects for which this Corporation is
formed are: To supply sell and
use water for power to run all
kinds of machinery and for ag-
ricultural and domestic purposes,
and generally to apply the same,
either by this Corporation itself or by
selling the use thereof to others, to
any and all useful purposes what-
soever. To that end, to acquire lands
and water rights and to sell and
dispose of the same, when expedi-
ent; to construct maintain and
operate dams canals, flumes, and
other means and appliances for con-
veying and controlling water and
applying the same to useful pur-
poses; and in general, to do any
and all things necessary, proper
or convenient to be done in and
about the carrying out of the busi-
ness above specified.
That its principal place of business

Shall be in the Town of Hailey, County
of Blaine and Territory of Idaho.
That the period of its existence shall
be Fifty (50) years from and after
the date of its incorporation.

That the number of its trustees shall
be Seven, and that the names of
those who shall be such trustees
in the first three months and
until their successors are duly
elected and qualified are:
