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Know All Men By These Presents, that we Amasa E. Campbell, John A. Finch, Edward S. Kinney, *John H. Dorsey and Patrick Clark* a majority of whom are resident freeholders, and bona fide residents, of the State of Idaho, do voluntarily associate ourselves together, for the purpose of forming a corporation, and becoming a body corporate, under the laws of Idaho, and we hereby declare and set forth:

First.

That the name of this Corporation is and shall be, The Standard Mining Company.

Second.

That this Corporation is formed for the purpose of purchasing, selling, bonding, leasing, working, and operating, Mines and Mining claims, Water rights, Mill sites and easements incident thereto, and such other real property, as may be lawfully acquired by a Corporation, under the laws of the United States, and the State of Idaho.

Purchasing, renting, leasing and building, Mills, Concentrators and other works, and machinery necessary for the purposes of Milling, Concentrating, Reducing and handling Ores and the products thereof.

Buying, selling, working, milling and concentrating Ores.

Third.

That the principal place of business of this Corporation, shall be at the town of Wallace, Shoshone County, State of Idaho.

Fourth.

That the term for which this Corporation shall exist, shall be fifty years.

Fifth.

That the Officers of this Corporation shall be termed Directors, and shall consist of five, and the names and residences of those, who are appointed for the first year, or until the first annual meeting of the Stockholders, are as follows:

Amasa E. Campbell, of Wallace, Idaho who shall be Director, and President of the said Corporation, for the said term of one year.-

John A. Finch, of Wallace, Idaho who shall be Director, and Vice President and Treasurer, of the said Corporation, for the said term of one year.-

Edward S. Kinney, of Wallace, Idaho who shall be Director, and Secretary, of the said Corporation, for the said term of one year.-

Charles W. Kipp, of Milwaukee, Wisconsin and Tod Ford, of Youngstown, Ohio who shall be Directors of the said Corporation, for the said term of one year.-

Sixth.

That the amount of the Capital stock of this Corporation shall be Five Hundred Thousand (500,000) dollars, and shall be divided in Five Hundred Thousand shares of the value of One (1) dollar each.


