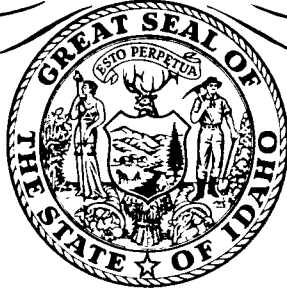

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
HOME FURNITURE COMPANY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Alma Blacker, Loyn Blacker and LeRoy Blacker, being of full age, and citizens of the United States of America, and actual and bona fide residents of the State of Idaho, have this day voluntarily associated ourselves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

FIRST: That the name of the corporation shall be

HOME FURNITURE COMPANY, INC.

SECOND: That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

(a) To operate and conduct a furniture, appliance and related mercantile business, to handle, buy, sell, retail, wholesale any and all kinds of furniture, appliances, general merchandise and all related products thereto, being a general furniture store but not limited to the handling of furniture and appliances, but it being the intention of the corporation to engage in any and all kinds and classes for the mercantile, wholesale and retail business.

(b) To borrow money and to issue notes, mortgages and other debentures therefor, and to mortgage, pledge, hypothecate or convey in trust any or all of its property to secure the payment thereof.

(c) To purchase, improve, develop, lease, exchange, sell, dispose of, and otherwise deal in and turn to account real estate in connection with the above purposes.

(d) To do any and all such other acts, things, business or business in any manner connected with or necessary, incidental, convenient or auxiliary to any of the objects hereinbefore enumerated, or calculated, directly or indirectly to promote the interest of the said corporation; and in carrying on its purposes, or for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its business, to do any and all things and acts, and to exercise any and all other powers which a co-partner or natural person could do or exercise, and which now or hereafter may be authorized by law.

THIRD: That the term of this corporation shall be perpetual.

FOURTH: That the Board of Directors shall consist of Three (3) persons.

FIFTH: That the registered office of the corporation shall be located at Rupert, Minidoka County, Idaho.

SIXTH: The capital stock of the corporation shall be Five Hundred (500) shares of no-par value stock.

SEVENTH: The capital stock of the corporation which has actually been subscribed is Five Hundred (500) shares, and the following are the names, post office addresses and shares:

EIGHTH: That the number of persons above named shall constitute the directors of the corporation until changed by amendment

to the by-laws, increasing or decreasing the number of directors, as may be desired, in the manner provided by law.

NINTH: That the Board of Directors shall have the power to amend or change the by-laws by unanimous consent of the members thereof.
