



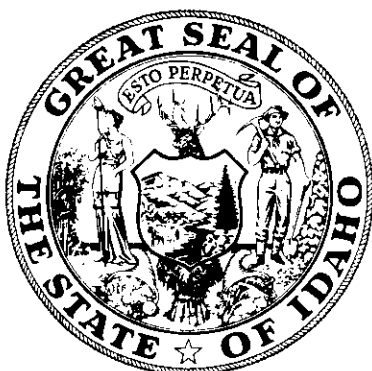

Articles of Incorporation of

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STATE OF WASHINGTON

DANCO, INCORPORATED

THE UNDERSIGNED, of the age of eighteen years, or more, desirous of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Washington, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I.

The name of this corporation shall be DANCO, INCORPORATED

ARTICLE II.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence.

ARTICLE III.

The purpose of the corporation is to engage in all forms and any such activity pertaining thereto not forbidden to corporations by the Constitution, statutes or common law of the State of Washington.

Forest products machinery (sales)

ARTICLE IV.

The capital stock of this corporation shall be \$ 50,000 consisting of

50,000 shares of common stock (of the par value of \$ 1.00 per share) ~~(with no par value)~~. Capital stock may be issued by the corporation from time to time for such consideration, including (without limitation) labor, services, money or property, as may be fixed by resolution of the Board of Directors from time to time.

No holder of shares of stock of this corporation shall be entitled as such as a matter of right to subscribe for, purchase, or otherwise acquire any share of stock of this corporation of any class whether now or hereafter authorized, or any securities convertible into shares of stock of this corporation.

ARTICLE V

This corporation shall not commence business until consideration of the value of at least Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) has been received for the issuance of shares.

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII

The number of directors of this corporation shall be such number, not less than three (3) except where all shares are owned of record by fewer than three (3) shareholders, in which case the number of directors shall not be less than the number of such shareholders and such number of directors shall be determined from time to time by the shareholders of the corporation.
