One Thousand Nine Hundred **Fifty-eight** and duly recorded on Film No. **103** of Record of Domestic Corporations, of the State of Idaho, and that the said articles contain the statement of facts required by Section 30-103, Idaho Code.

I FURTHER CERTIFY, That the persons executing the articles and their associates and successors are hereby constituted a corporation, by the name hereinbefore stated, for **perpetual existence** from the date hereof, with its registered office in this State located at **Boise** in the County of **Ada**

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
W W & R CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, CLEMIS L. WRIGHT, CARL H. WEAVER, and HENRY F. REED, being each persons of full age, residents of the State of Idaho, and citizens of the United States, desiring to form a General Business Corporation under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter I of Title 30 of the Idaho Code, and we do hereby certify, declare and adopt the following articles of incorporation:

I

The name of the corporation is W W & R CONSTRUCTION COMPANY, INC.

II

The nature, objects and purposes of this corporation shall be to do any and all of the things hereafter set forth to the same extent as natural persons might or could do in any part of the world, namely:

To carry on and conduct a general contracting business, including the designing, constructing, enlarging, repairing, remodeling or otherwise engaging in any work upon buildings, roads, side walks, high ways, bridges, public works of all types and description, or manufacturing plants; and to engage in iron, steel, wood, brick, concrete, stone, cement, masonry and earth construction, and to execute contracts or to receive assignments of contracts therefor, or relating thereto; also, to manufacture and furnish the building materials and supplies connected herewith.

To manage, lease, purchase or otherwise acquire and to hold, own, sell or dispose of real estate and do such things in connection therewith as shall be convenient, necessary or required by this corporation in the conducting of its business and at such places as the board of directors may determine.

To borrow money for its corporate purposes, and to make, accept, indorse, execute and issue promissory notes, bills of exchange, bonds, debentures or other obligations from time to time, for the purpose of purchasing property, or for any other purpose in or about the business of the corporation, and if deemed proper, to secure the payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed of trust or otherwise.

To acquire, and take over as a going concern and thereafter to carry on the business of any person, firm, or corporation engaged in any business which this corporation is authorized to carry on, and in connection therewith to acquire the good will and all or any of the assets, and to assume or otherwise provide for all or any of the liabilities of any such business.

To sell, improve, manage, develop, lease, mortgage, dispose of or otherwise turn to account or deal with all or any part of the property of the corporation.

To carry on business at any place or places within the jurisdiction of the United States, and in any and all foreign countries, and to purchase, hold, mortgage, convey, lease or otherwise dispose of and deal with real and personal property at any such place or places.

To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind which may be necessary or convenient for the business of the corporation or business of a similar nature, with any person, firm, corporation, private, public or municipal body politic under the government of the United States, or any state, territory or colony thereof or any foreign government, so far as and to the extent that the same may be done and performed by corporations organized under the General Corporation Law.

To do all and every thing necessary, suitable or proper for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, the attainment of any of the objects or the furtherance of any of the powers hereinbefore set forth, either alone or in connection with other corporations, firms or individuals and either as principals, or agents and to do every

other act or acts, thing or things, incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the aforesaid objects, purposes or powers of any of them.

The foregoing enumeration of specific powers shall not be deemed to limit or restrict in any manner the general powers of the corporation, and the enjoyment and exercise thereof, as conferred by the laws of the State of Idaho upon corporations organized under the provisions of Chapter I of Title 30, Idaho Code.

### III

This corporation shall have a total authorized capital of Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), divided into 1,000 shares of the par value of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per share.

### IV

Each of the stock holders of record shall be entitled at all meetings of the corporation and in any other matters requiring a vote, to one vote for each share of stock standing in his name upon the books of the corporation. In voting for directors or officers the stock may be voted cumulatively.

### V

The office of the corporation shall be located at 714 $\frac{1}{2}$  N. Orchard Avenue, Boise, Idaho.

### VI

The duration of the corporation is to be perpetual.

### VII

The number of directors is to be not less than three (3) or more than seven (7) in number. The directors need not be stock holders.

### VIII

No contract or other transaction of the corporation with any other person, firm or corporation or in which this corporation is interested shall be affected or invalidated by the fact that any one or more of the directors of this corporation is interested in or is a director or officer of another corporation; or the fact that any director, individually or jointly with others, may be a party to or may be interested in any such contract or transaction, and each and every person who may become a director of the corporation is hereby relieved from any liability that might otherwise arise by reason of his contracting with the corporation for the benefit of himself or any firm, or corporation in which he may be in any wise interested.

X

The shares of stock shall not be transferred in any manner whatsoever unless the holder thereof first offers them to the corporation at book value.
