

Article of Agreement




Made this first day of October 1879 between Amos Woodward of Bellevue, Huron Co, Ohio B. S. White, of Beaver Canon, Oneida County, Idaho Ter. and John C. Anderson of Eagle Rock, Oneida County Idaho. Witnesses: That we have this day formed ourselves into a Corporation to be known as the "Snake River Water Company" in Oneida County Idaho Ter. - The object of said Corporation is to take water from the South Fork of Snake River and convey same by canal and laterals down Snake River valley for furnishing and disposing of same for Mining, Mechanical, Transportation, Agricultural and other purposes. The Amount of Capital of said Corporation to be Fifteen Thousand Dollars, consisting of One hundred and fifty shares of one hundred dollars each. The Term of Existence of said Corporation to be Fifty Years

The number of Trustees of said Corporation shall be three, viz:
Amos Woodward, B. F. White,
And John C. Anderson.

The principal place of business of said Corporation is to be located at Eagle Rock Nevada County, Idaho Territory.

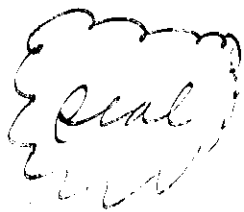
