ARTICLE 6: <u>Board of Directors</u>. All corporate powers shall be exercised by or under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the corporation managed under the direction of, it's board of directors, subject to any limitation set forth in a shareholder agreement authorized under section 30-1-732, Idaho Code. The number of directors constituting the initial board of directors shall be one (1), and the name and address of the person to serve as director until the first annual meeting of shareholders or until or until their successor is elected and qualified is:

ARTICLE 7: <u>Corporate Purpose</u>. The purpose for which this corporation is organized is the transaction of any and all lawful business for which such corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Corporation Act. The primary purpose for which this corporation is organized is food service.

ARTICLE 8: Preemptive Rights. The corporation elects to have preemptive rights.

ARTICLE 9: <u>Limitation of Liability</u>. No director shall be liable to the corporation or it's shareholders for monetary damages for breach of fiduciary duty except liability for: (i) the amount of a financial benefit received by a director to which he is not entitled; (ii) an intentional infliction of harm on the professional corporation or it's shareholders; (iii) a violation of section 30-1-833 Idaho Code; or (iv) an intentional violation of criminal law.
