KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of legal age and citizens of the United States of America, in order to form a corporation for the purposes hereinafter stated, pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

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NAME

The name of the corporation shall be BAR S&J CONSTRUCTION CORP.

II.

REGISTERED OFFICE

The location and post office address of the registered office of the corporation shall be 11756 W. Roosevelt Avenue, Nampa, Idaho 83686.

III.

REGISTERED AGENT

IV.

DURATION

The period of existence and duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

BYLAWS

The Directors of this corporation shall not be liable to the shareholders for money damages for any action taken, or any failure to take any action, as a director except for action taken, or any failure to take any action, as a director and the director received financial benefit to which he was not entitled and limited to that amount and/or the intentional infliction of harm to this corporation or its shareholders and/or a violation of Section 30-1-833 Idaho Code and/or an intentional violation of criminal law.

XIII.

INDEMNIFICATION OF DIRECTORS FOR LIABILITY

It is obligatory for this corporation to indemnify director liability to any person for any action taken, or any failure to take any action as a director, except for liability for receipt by the director of a financial benefit to which the director is not entitled, and/or an intentional infliction of harm to this corporation or its shareholders, and/or a violation of Section 30-1-833 Idaho Code and/or an intentional violation of criminal law.

XIV.

DIRECTOR CONFLICTS OF INTEREST

No contract or other transaction between the corporation and any other corporation, whether or not a majority of the shares of the capital stock of such other corporation is owned by the corporation, and no act of the corporation, shall be in any way affected or invalidated by the fact that any of the directors' interest in that of the corporation are pecuniary or otherwise interested in, or are directors or officers of such other corporation; any director individually, or any firm of which such director may be a member, may be a party to, or may have pecuniary or other interest in, any contract or transaction of the corporation, provided that the fact that he or such firm is so interested shall be disclosed or shall have been known to the Board of Directors; and the director of the corporation who is also so interested may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum at any meeting of the Board of Directors of the corporation which shall authorize such contract or transaction, with like force and effect as if he were not such a director or officer of such other corporation, or not so interested.
