ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

TO THE SECRETARY OF STATE OF THE STATE OF IDAHO:

STATE OF IDAHO

The undersigned, in order to form a Corporation under the provisions of Title 30, Chapter 3, Idaho Code, submits the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE 1: The name of the corporation shall be REACH Club, Inc.

ARTICLE 2: The purpose for which the corporation is organized is the transaction of any lawful activity.

ARTICLE 3: The street address of the registered office is 100 School Road, Elk City, ID 83525, and the registered agent at such address is Susie Borowicz.

ARTICLE 4: The board of directors shall consist of no fewer than three (3) people and no more than seven (7) people. The names and addresses of the initial directors are: Dave Paisley, P.O. Box 191, Elk City, ID 83525; Marty Brint, P.O. Box 524, Elk City, ID 83525; and Grace Altman, P.O. Box 386, Elk City, ID 83525.

ARTICLE 5: The name and address of the incorporators are Dave Paisley, P.O. Box 191, Elk City, ID 83525 and Marty Brint, P.O. Box 524, Elk City, ID 83525.

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1 **ARTICLE 6:** The mailing address of the corporation shall be


3 **ARTICLE 7:** The Corporation does not have voting members.

4 **ARTICLE 8:** (a) The organization is organized exclusively
5 for charitable, religious, educational, and/or scientific
6 purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

8 (b) No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure
9 to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees,
10 officers or other private persons, except that the organization
11 shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation
12 for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in
13 furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause
14 hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the
15 organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise
16 attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall
17 not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or
18 distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of
19 any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other
20 provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on
21 any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an
22 organization exempt from federal income tax under section
23 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or by corresponding
24 section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an
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1 organization, contributions to which are deductible under section
2 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section
3 of any future federal tax code.

4 (c) Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be
5 distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of
6 section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding
7 section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed
8 to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for
9 a public purpose.

12 corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho as
13 aforementioned, the undersigned, constituting the incorporators
14 of this corporation, have executed these Articles of
