ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF IDA-CHARGE CREDIT CARD CO. * * * * *

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned, all of whom are natural persons of full age and are citizens of the United States, have this day volumtarily associated our selves together for the purpose of forming a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and we do hereby certify:

Ι

That the name of this corporation shall be IDA-CHARGE CREDIT CARD CO.

II

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

- l. To institute, organize, engage in and conduct the business of establishing, dealing in and in any manner making available credit services, professional or otherwise, including, without limiting the generality of the foregoing, issuing selling and in any other manner dealing in or with credit evaluation systems, collections, credit systems, credit cards, guarantees, evidences of indebtedness and all other commercial paper or securities.
- 2. To purchase or otherwise acquire, and to hold, own, maintain, work, develop, sell, lease, exchange, hire, convey, mortgage or otherwise dispose of and deal in, lands and leaseholds and any interests, estate and rights in real property, and any personal or mixed property, and any franchises, rights, licenses or privileges necessary, convenient or appropriate for any of the purposes herein expressed.
- 3. To borrow money, and to make and issue notes, bonds, debentures, obligations and evidences of indebtedness of all kinds, whether secured by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, without limit as to amount, and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge or otherwise, and generally to make and perform agreements and contracts of every kind and description.
- 4. To carry on any other lawful business whatsoever which may seem to the corporation capable of being carried on in connection with the above, or calculated, directly or indirectly, to promote the interest of the corporation or to enhance the valuation of its property.
- 5. To exercise and have all powers granted to or conferred upon business corporations by or under the laws of the

State of Idaho or any other state in which the corporation may qualify to do business.

III

Subject to dissolution in the manner provided by law, the duration of this corporation shall be perpetual.

IV

That the principal place of business, registered office and the location and post office address of the registered office of said corporation shall be Idaho Falls, County of Bonneville, State of Idaho.

V

That the total authorized capital stock of said corporation shall be TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND AND NO/100 DOLLARS (\$250,000.00), divided into Two Hundred Fifty Thousand (250,000) shares of the par value of ONE AND NO/100 DOLLAR (\$1.00) each, and all of said stock shall be common stock, which said stock shall be non-assessable, except with the consent of the holders of all of the outstanding stock of said corporation.

VI

The number of directors of said corporation shall be not less than three (3) nor more than nine (9), as hereafter fixed, and determined by the By-Laws of the corporation.

IIV

That the Board of Directors shall have the power to repeal and amend the By-Laws of the corporation and adopt new By-Laws at any meeting of the Board of Directors. All By-Laws shall be subject to amendment, alteration and repeal by the stockholders at any annual meeting or any special meeting called for such purposes.
