ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

MELBA VALLEY CHAMBER OF COMMERCE INC

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

the undersigned, all residents of the State of We. Idaho, and citizens of the United States of America, for the purpose of forming a non-profit association pursuant to Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, for the purposes expressed herin, do hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be Melba Valley Chamber of Commerce, Inc. The principle business of said organization shall be transacted in Melba, County of Canyon, Idaho. (P. B. Box 62) The shall be Clint Agenbroad, 3rd street, Melba Idaho.

ARTICLE II

organization shall be dedicated to the both material and cultural, of the city of Melba and betterment, the surrounding areas immediatly adjacent thereto. It is also the purpose of the organization to foster, encourage, or assist in promoting better business and professional atmosphere, and to engage in any and all lawfull business purposes, including not limited to the purchase and sale of Promissory Notes, Deeds of Trust and Mortgages.

ARTICLE III

The government of this corporation, and the management of its affairs, shall be vested in a Board of Directors consisting of not less five (5) nor more than nine (9) members, and within such limits, the number, and qualifications, term of office, manner of election, and powers and duties of Directors shall be fixed and may be altered from time to time, as may be provided for in the Bylaws. The incorporators shall act in the capacity of Directors of this Corporation until their successors are elected and qualified. Directors shall serve for one (1) year.

ARTICLE V

This corporation is formed without any purpose of financial profit, and there shall be no financial profit for the Corporation, its members, or its officers, thus shall be considered a non-profit organization under the laws of the state of Idaho and the United States of America. There shall be no capital stock at this time, but yearly dues may be provided for in the By-laws.

ARTICLE VI

- A. All Corporations, Firms, Business Establishments or reputable persons, who are a citizen of the United States, reguardless of race, religion or political viewpoint, are eligible for membership as provided for in the By-laws.
- B. Voting power of the members of this Corporation shall be equal and each member shall have one vote only.

ARTICLE VI

For the purpose of carrying out said objectives and purpose, the corporation may, with the authority of two-thirds of the Board of Directors, acquire and recieve in its Corporate name by purchase, gift, grant, or bequeth, any real or personal property, and to hold, transfer, sell, morgage, convey, let or otherwise use the same.

ARTICLE VII

The Corporation shall have as its Officers: a President, Vice-President, Treasurer and Secretary. The officers shall be elected by the general membership at the annual meeting and shall serve for one (1) year.

ARTICLE VIII

The Board of Directors and all officers shall be elected at the annual meeting by the members of the Association. The annual meeting shall be the first meeting in April.

ARTICLE X

Upon the dissolution of this Association for any cause, all the property both real and personal then owned or controlled by this Association shall become the absolute property of such tax exempt corporation as shall be designated in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE XII

The private property of the members of the Association shall not be subject to the payment of corporate debts and no member shall become individually liable or responsible for any debts or liabilities of the corporation.
