## RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

We, the undersigned, president and secretary of Long Island Irrigation Company, hereby verify that the following restated Articles of Incorporation of Long Island Irrigation Company correctly set forth without change the corresponding provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as heretofore amended, verify that the following restated Articles of Incorporation of Long Island Irrigation Company and all amendments thereto, and further verify that the Articles of Incorporation of Long Island Irrigation Company are restated pursuant to a resolution of the Board of Directors of Long Island Irrigation Company.

I.

That the name of said corporation shall be the "LONG ISLAND IRRIGATION COMPANY".

II.

That the purposes for which said corporation is formed are:

a. By amendment and re-incorporation, take over, by merger, re-incorporation, as well as by all other lawful means, all of the assets, rights, privileges, franchises, property, both real and personal, of every kind and character and description now owned by the said Long Island Irrigating Company, and to continue as said Company under the name of the "LONG ISLAND IRRIGATION COMPANY", whether as the successor in interest, or by merger, or by amendment to the existing Articles of Incorporation of the said Long Island Irrigating Company.

- b. To construct, or otherwise acquire, to own, manage, control or otherwise operate canals and irrigation systems, and particularly that certain canal and irrigation system now known as The Long Island Canal, and which was constructed and has at all times been operated by the Long Island Irrigating Company, and which said canal has its main headgate on the South Bank of the South Fork of Snake River, at a point about one-half mile up-stream from the East one-half mile post of Section thirty-three (33), Township five (5) North, Range thirty-nine (39) East Boise Meridian, and which canal has been in operation since about the year 1880.
- c. To acquire, by purchase, assignment, appropriation, or otherwise, water rights of all kinds and description, and to hold, use, pledge, sell or transfer water rights of all kinds and descriptions.
- d. To acquire, by purchase or otherwise, title to all real property that may be necessary in the futherance and the conduct of the business of this corporation, and to pledge and mortgage such property, and to dispose of any and all property, both real and personal, owned by the said corporation, and which is not required for its own use.
- e. To conduct and manage an irrigation canal system primarily for the benefit of the stockholders of said corporation, and not for pecuniary profit, and the incorporators hereof do hereby declare that the said corporation has been and is formed, primarily, for the benefit of the said stockholders and not for any pecuniary profit, and that its chief purpose is to distribute to the various stockholders, and such other parties as shall, from time to time, have the right to use the water from said canal, certain water rights and the waters represented by the same, and which

have heretofore been decreed to the said Long Island Irrigating Company, and to do all and every necessary and needful thing in connection therewith.

- f. To borrow money, and to pledge, incumber, or in any other mannner hypothecate any and all corporate property for the payment of the same.
- g. To do any and everything necessary in connection with the conduct of the business of said corporation, and particularly all things that are permitted under the Laws of the State of Idaho to similar corporations, the said incorporators seeking hereby to take advantage of every provision granted to canal companies under the Laws of the State of Idaho.

III.

That its principal place of business is at Menan, Jefferson County, Idaho.

IV.

This corporation shall have perpetual existence from and after this date.

VI.

That the amount of capital stock shall be Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$60,000.00), the same to be divided into Sixty Thousand shares of the par value of One Dollar per share.

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The capital stock of the corporation may not be transferred except in connection with a transaction involving title to the real property to which that proportion of the water and conveyance rights of the corporation represented by such stock is appurtenant, or as otherwise provided by the By-Laws of the corporation, and only to the extend and in the manner provided in the said By-Laws and as the same may from time to time be amended.

XI.

Those shareholders present at an annual or special shareholder's meeting shall constitute a quorum for purposes of transacting any business before the meeting.
