Hailey Tramway Company, a corporation.

Findings and Decree of Dissolution.

This cause coming on to be heard in open Court at Hailey, Idaho, this 27th day of November, 1927, the petitioner, the Hailey Tramway Company, a corporation, being represented by J.C. Hedrick, its attorney, and no one appearing to protest against the application for dissolution of the said Hailey Tramway Company, an Idaho Corporation; and it further appearing to me the Judge of the said Court, that a petition was duly filed in the said action asking for the dissolution of the said Hailey Tramway Company, a corporation, and that an order was made by me the Judge of the said Court on October 21, 1927, ordering the Clerk of the said Court to file the said petition in the said action, and authorizing and directing the said Clerk to give notice of not less than thirty days of the hearing on the said petition by publication in the Hailey Times, a newspaper published at Hailey, in Blaine County, Idaho, the County in which the said corporation was engaged in business and where its principal place of business is located; and that the said Clerk, pursuant to the said order, gave the required thirty days notice by publication in the said newspaper; and that the said thirty days have expired and that no objections have been filed against the dissolution of the said corporation; and the Court, after hearing the testimony submitted for and on behalf of the said petitioner and being fully advised in the premises now finds as follows:-

1. That all of the material allegations of the said petition

are true and correct.

2. That the said Hailey Tramway Company, was duly organized as a corporation, under the laws of the State of Idaho, on August 28, 1929, and ever since has been and now is a corporation under the laws of the State of Idaho, and engaged in business in the County of Blaine, State of Idaho.

3. That at a meeting of the stockholders and directors of the said Hailey Tramway Company, called for that purpose, held on the 1st day of July, 1936, at which meeting all of the stockholders of the said company were present or represented by proxy, a resolution was unanimously adopted authorizing the dissolution of the said corporation and directing the Directors of the said company to take such steps as were necessary and proper to effectuate the intent and purpose of the said resolution.

4. That all claims and demands against the said company have been satisfied and discharged; and that the said corporation should be dissolved according to law.

Now, Therefore, on motion of J. G. Pedrick, attorney for the said Petitioner:

It is Ordered, adjudged and Decreed that the said Corporation, Hailey Tramway Company, be and the same is hereby wholly dissolved in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 3, Title 29, of the Idaho Code Annotated.
