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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

SUN VALLEY RESORT AREA MARKETING, INC.

A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

1. SUN VALLEY RESORT AREA MARKETING, INC is organized exclusively as an association of persons having a common business interest, whose purpose is to promote the economic growth and development of the resort community of Sun Valley, Idaho and surrounding areas and not to engage in a regular business of a kind ordinarily carried for profit. Its activities are directed to the improvement of business conditions of one or more lines of business rather than the performance of particular services for individual persons and is an to organization that qualifies as exempt organization under section 501 (c) (6) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

No part of the net earnings of the Organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Organization shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (c) (6) or the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code

8. Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of the section 501 (c) (6) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas in the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organization, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
