and as such are subject to the rights, privileges and limitations granted to Non-Profit Cooperative Associations as provided in Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of AERO - ED, INC.,

Grangeville, Idaho.

We, the undersigned, have associated, and do hereby associate ourselves together for the formation of a corporation under the provisions of Chapter 10, Title 30, Idaho Code, and in conformance with the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

Ι.

That the name of the corporation is Aero-Ed, Inc.

TT.

That the purposes of the corporation shall be to promote and encourage aviation and aeronautical activities; to develop and promote the dissemination of aeronautical studies and information, and other matters of interest allied thereto; to acquire, and provide, for its members, facilities and materials for the study and engagement in aviation, aeronautical, meteorological activities and pursuits; to foster and cultivate, among the members and in the community or communities wherein the corporation shall engage in its activites, a friendly spirit of mutual co-operation in fulfillment of the aims and purposes of the corporation; to improve, by any lawful means, the individual status and condition of its members and the betterment of the community, or communities in which the activities of the corporation may be carried on; and to educate and qualify persons in piloting skills and to provide aircraft for training, and for personal transportation at an economical rate.

III.

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual, except as the same may be limited by law.

The principal place of business, and the location of the registered office of the corporation shall be at Grangeville, Idaho County, Idaho, but offices may be established elsewhere as the directors of the corporation may determine.

V.

The corporation shall have no capital stock and shall not engage in any business for profit, and if any of the activities of the corporation result in income in excess of expense, such excess shall be used in accord with the stated purposes and aims of the corporation, and shall never inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to any individual, officer or member of the corporation.

VI.

Except as limited by these articles, the corporation shall have and exercise all the powers granted to corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho, including the power to acquire, own, sell, trade, exchange, mortgage, lease, or otherwise deal with real and personal property, so long as such activities are engaged in, and limited to the stated purposes of the organization.

VII.

The officers by whom, and the manner in which the objectives and purposes of the corporation shall be carried out, shall be as provided in the by-laws of the corporation.
