ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CONTRACT FLOORS, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age, citizens of the United States of America and residents of the State of Idaho, this day have voluntarily associated ourselves for the purpose of forming a corporation under and pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho and we do hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation shall be:

CONTRACT FLOORS, INC.

ARTICLE II

The purposes for which this corporation is formed and the powers which this corporation shall exercise are:

(a) To make estimates for itself and for others, and to bid upon, enter into, and carry out contracts for the building and construction of walks, paths, walkways, and floors of every type and description; the construction of buildings, bridges, piers, wharves, fortifications, power plants, and developments, transmission lines, tunnels, subways, drainage, and irrigation systems. To do bidding, estimating, building, structural, construction, erection, surveying, dredging, shoring, wrecking, salvage, and electrical work of every kind in every part of the world. To manufacture or otherwise produce, buy, sell, and deal in building materials, and all kinds of materials, supplies, and equipment for masons, contractors, carpenters, builders,

electricians, and engineers. To acquire, use, employ, sell and deal in all suitable means, apparatus, machinery, contrivances, equipment, and facilities for prosecuting its business.

(b) To carry on a general manufacturing, merchandising, and trading business and any business incidental thereto or any way connected therewith, and particularly to produce, manufacture, make work treat, grow, mine, get, store, hold as bailee or warehouseman, prepare for market, advertise, pledge, use, lease or otherwise dispose of or turn to account, and generally to deal in and render services with respect to goods, wares, merchandise, commodities, and personal property of every kind and description, including, but not without limiting in any manner the generality of the foregoing, carpets, rugs, carpet cushions, and floor coverings and materials, whether soft surface or hard surface, and whether made of wool, cotton, silk, flax, hemp, jute, sisal, rayon, other fibers, rubber, glass, paper, plastics, concrete, clay, or other materials, synthetic or otherwise; cloths, threads, yarns, and fabrics of all manner and kinds, and suitable for any use or uses whatsoever; articles of any nature of metal, wood, paper, glass, rubber, plastics, or any other material, synthetic or otherwise; and machinery, apparatus, equipment, supplies, tools, and articles of any kind useful in connection with the manufacture of any of the foregoing.

(c) To buy, sell, barter, exchange and deal generally at wholesale, retail, and as broker, in articles of trade including furniture and furnishings, electrical appliances, fixtures, groceries, shoes, clothing, hardware, farm machinery, farm products, and all other articles of trade, barter or exchange.

(d) To purchase or otherwise acquire, own, maintain and operate trucks or truck lines or other media of transportation or conveyance for the handling and carrying of goods, wares and merchandise.

(e) To purchase, acquire, own, hold, lease (either as lessor or as lessee), sell, exchange, subdivide, mortgage and generally operate any real or personal property of any and every kind or description, within or without the State of Idaho, necessary, suitable or useful in connection with any of the objects or purposes herein set forth.

(f) To construct and erect buildings or structures upon and to improve and maintain any and all real property owned, leased or held by this corporation; and to equip, improve and generally operate any and all personal property owned by this corporation.

(g) To purchase, hold, sell and transfer the shares of its own capital stock; provided, it shall not use its funds or property for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when such use would cause any impairment of its capital; and provided further that the shares of its own capital stock owned by it shall not be voted upon directly or indirectly.

(h) To enter into, make, perform and carry out contracts of every sort and kind which may be necessary or desirable for the furtherance of the business of this corporation, with any persons, firms, corporations, associations, any state, territory, or municipality of the United States or any foreign country, government or body politic.

(i) To acquire and hold all or any part of the capital stock, assets or good will of any business, or any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in any business in whole or in part similar or not to that of this corporation, and to hold, utilize and in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the stock, assets, good will and rights so acquired and to conduct in any lawful manner in whole or in part any business so acquired, and to undertake or assume the whole or any part of the obligations or liabilities of any person, firm, association or corporation engaged in the business so acquired.

(j) To borrow money for any purpose of this corporation, without limit as to amount, and to issue bonds, debentures, notes, or other evidences of indebtedness, secured or unsecured of this corporation for the moneys so borrowed, or in payment for property acquired, or for any other objects or purposes of this corporation, or in connection with its business; to secure payment of such debentures, notes, or other obligations by mortgages, or deeds of trust or pledges or other liens upon any or all of the property of this corporation wheresoever situated.

(k) To carry out all or any part of the foregoing objects or purposes as principal or agent, or otherwise, either alone or in conjunction with any person, association or other corporation and in any part of the world; and in carrying on its business and for the purpose of attaining or furthering any of its objects or purposes, to make and perform such contracts of any kind and description, to do such acts and such things, and to exercise any and all such powers as a natural person could lawfully make, perform, and do or exercise, provided that the same be not inconsistent with the objects of the State of Idaho.

(l) To conduct its business in all or any of its branches, in the State of Idaho and in any and all other states, territories, possessions, colonies and dependencies of the United States of America and in the District of Columbia, and in any or all foreign countries, and to have one or more offices within or outside of the State of Idaho.

(m) To carry on and undertake any business undertaking, transaction or operation commonly carried on or undertaken by capitalists, promoters, financiers, concessionaires, contractors, brokers, and commission merchants and any other incidental business which may seem to the company convenient to carry on in connection with the above, or calculated directly or indirectly to enhance the value of or render profitable any of the company's property or rights.

(n) To adopt, apply for and register, purchase, lease or otherwise acquire and to use, maintain, and protect and to sell, assign, or grant licenses or other rights in respect of any trade marks, trade names, patents, patent rights, copyrights, inventions, formulas, processes and rights analogous thereto.

(o) The objects as specified herein shall, except as otherwise expressed, be in no way limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other clause or paragraph of these Articles. The objects, purposes and powers specified in each of the clauses or paragraphs in these Articles shall be regarded as independent objects, purposes and powers.

The foregoing shall be construed as objects and powers and the enumeration thereof shall not be held to limit or restrain in any manner the general powers now or hereafter conferred on this corporation by the statutes of the State of Idaho.

### ARTICLE III

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual.

### ARTICLE IV

The principal office or place of business of the corporation shall be at 4348 State Street, Boise,

Ada County, Idaho; but the corporation may maintain an office in such towns, cities, and places within or outside the State of Idaho as the Board of Directors may from time to time determine, or as may be designated by the By-Laws of said corporation.

#### ARTICLE V

The amount of the total authorized capital stock of this corporation is \$50,000.00 consisting of 500 shares of common stock at a par value of \$100.00 each per share.

#### ARTICLE VI

The members of the governing board of this corporation are styled "Directors" and the Board of Directors shall consist of not less than three members, nor more than seven, as may be provided by the By-Laws of the corporation.

#### ARTICLE VII

The capital stock of this corporation shall be nonassessable; and the private property of the shareholders, and each of them, of this corporation, shall not be subject to assessment or be liable for the debts, obligations or liabilities of this corporation.

ARTICLE VIII


ARTICLE IX
