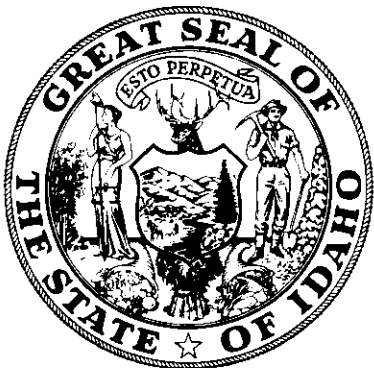

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF THE
IDAHO HOMEOPATHIC MEDICAL ASSOCIATION, INC.

We, the undersigned persons, acting as the incorporators of a corporation under the provisions of the Idaho Non-profit Corporation Act (Revised Code of Idaho 30.601), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for said Corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be the Idaho Homeopathic Medical Association, *Inc.*

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

This corporation is organized for professional, educational and research purposes, within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Code of 1954, to act as a non-profit, professional, educational and research organization, dedicated to the perpetuation and advancement of the principles and practice of Homeopathic Medicine as a separate and distinct entity, from the degenerate Allopathic monopoly, in the State of Idaho and for the citizens of Idaho. This Holistic approach to human, animal and botanical disorders is a basic tenet of the Association. It includes any and all homeopathic substances presently known, in all strengths and titrations, any and all substances currently in a state of research or proving and any and all substances which may come within the scope of Homeopathic Medical research at any time or location in the future or any substance which has been, is now, or at any time in the future will be administered in potencies which are

homeopathic in nature or which are directly or indirectly related to homeopathy by virute of minute dosage.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation shall not permit pecuniary gain or profit to its member as a result of its activity, directly or indirectly, and is organized for non-profit purposes and no part of any net earnings thereof, shall unure to benefit to any member or any other individual.

ARTICLE V

Upon dissolution of the Corporation the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for professional, edcuational, research or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine.

ARTICLE VI

The initial registered office of the Corporation shall be Dr. Solomons' Office, 1942 Addison, Twin Falls, Idaho, and the initial registered agent shall be Dr. Solomon.

ARTICLE VII

The management of the Corporation will be vested in a Board of Directors; the number of Directors shall not be less than three, and shall initially be three, and the number, qualifcations, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of

meeting and the powers and duties of Directors shall be such as prescribed by the By-Laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

The names and addresses of the Directors who will first manage the affairs of the Corporation are as follows: Dr. James and Joan Solomon, 1942 Addison Ave. E., Twin Falls, Idaho and Dr. C. C. Wilcher, P.O. Box 43, Paul, Idaho.

ARTICLE IX

The Corporation shall have all powers granted to non-profit corporations by the laws of the State of Idaho, but the Board of Directors is specifically authorized to disclaim or to limit the powers of the Corporation if deemed necessary or desirable for the purpose of qualifying the Corporation for any gift, loan or other transaction, and the Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this Corporation.

ARTICLE X

All rights conferred upon the members of the Corporation are subject to the reserved right to amend, change, or repeal any provision contained in the Articles of Incorporation in the manner prescribed by law.

ARTICLE XI
