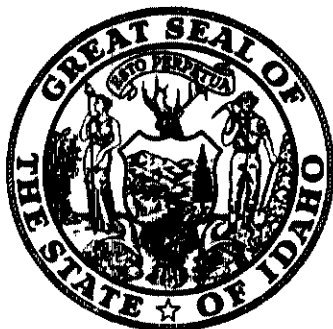
CERTIFICATE OF AMENDMENT OF

AMENDED & RESTATED

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

THE PROFESSIONAL BAIL AGENTS OF IDAHO, INCORPORATED

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THE UNDERSIGNED, acting as incorporators under the IDAHO
NONPROFIT CORPORATION ACT in effect on this, The 17th day
of September, 1992, at our annual meeting with a Quorum
present and a unanimous vote of the membership, hereby adopt
the following Articles of Incorporation for such nonprofit
corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is the Professional Bail
Agents of Idaho, Incorporated.

AMENDED ARTICLE II

This corporation is a corporation not for profit.
This organization is organized exclusively for charitable
purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the
Internal Revenue Code.

AMENDED ARTICLE III

The period of duration of the corporation is perpetual.
Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the
corporation shall not carry on any other activities not per-
mitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from
Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal
Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any
future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a
corporation contributions to which are deductible under section
170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or correspond-
ing provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE IV

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is to
establish and maintain a statewide, voluntary association of
persons engaged in the bail bond industry within the State of
Idaho.

ARTICLE V

Management of the affairs of the corporation is vested
by the Board of Directors who shall be elected by the members
in the manner set forth in the by-laws.

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ARTICLE VI

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation is P.O. Box 45097, Boise, Idaho 84711.

ARTICLE VII

The initial registered agent of the corporation is Kathy Cladis, whose address is 2316 Palouse Street, Boise, Idaho 83711.

AMENDED ARTICLE VIII

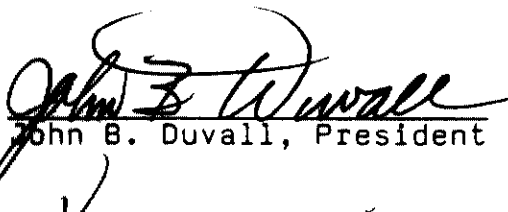
Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future tax code), or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

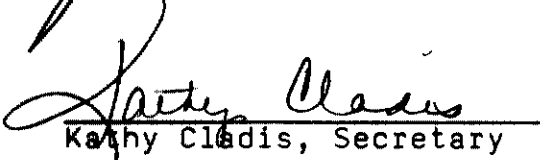
