ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

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OF

DATA-MATRIX, INC.

The undersigned, acting as incorporators of a corporation under the Idaho Business Corporation act, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for the corporation, Data-Matrix, Inc.:

FIRST:

The name of the corporation shall be Data-Matrix, Inc.

SECOND:

The period of the duration of this corporation, Data-Matrix, Inc., is perpetual.

THIRD:

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are the following:

To engage in the business of marketing, selling, promoting, and generally disseminating, in both the wholesale and retail markets, electronic business machines and data and word processors, including computers, computer systems, computer tie-in systems, and all other forms of electronic business machines and computers and word processors and data processors and their components, within the State of Idaho and other states within the United States.

In addition to the primary purpose set forth above, the general purpose for the existence of the corporation shall be the transaction of any or all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under the Idaho Business Corporation Act.

FOURTH:

POWERS OF THE CORPORATION

This corporation shall have all of the powers specified in the Idaho Business Corporation Act, Section 30-1-4 of the Idaho Code, and the following powers:

(1) To engage in any business or trade, which in the opinion of the directors of this corporation, may be advantageously carried

on, in connection with the corporation's primary business, and to do everything necessary, suitable, or proper, for the accomplishment of any of the purposes, the attainment of any of the objects, or the exercise of any of the powers herein set forth, either alone or in conjunction with other corporations, firms, businesses, or individuals, and either as principals or agents, and to do every other act or acts, thing or things, which are incidental or appurtenant to or growing out of or connected with the above mentioned objects, purposes, or powers.

- (2) To buy, exchange, acquire by lease, purchase, contract, concession, or otherwise, and to own, develop, explore, exploit, improve, operate, lease, enjoy, control, manage, or otherwise turn to account, mortgage, grant, sell, exchange, convey, or otherwise dispose of, either within or without the State of Idaho, and in any state of the United States, and in any country, any and all real property, lands, options, concessions, grants, land patents, franchises, rights, privileges, easements, tenements, estates, hereditaments, interests, and properties of every description and nature whatsoever, which the corporation may deem wise and proper in connection with the conduct of any business or businesses herein set forth.
 - (3) To subscribe for, acquire by purchase or otherwise, and to own, hold, sell, assign, and transfer, shares of capital stock of any other corporation and to exercise all the rights of a stock-holder; and, to acquire by purchase or otherwise hold, and dispose of, the stock and bonds of this corporation.
 - (4) To acquire all or any part of the goodwill, rights, property, and business of any person, firm, association, or corporation heretofore or hereafter engaged in any business similar to the business of this corporation, or otherwise, and to pay for it in cash or in stock or obligations of the corporation or otherwise, and to hold, utilize, enjoy, and in any manner dispose of the whole or any part of the rights and property so acquired, and to assume in connection therewith any liabilities of any such person,

firm, association, or corporation, and to conduct in any lawful manner within the State of Idaho, and within any other state, territory, locality, or country, the whole or any part of the business thus acquired, provided such business is not prohibited by laws of the State of Idaho.

- (5) To promote and assist, financially or otherwise, corporations, firms, syndicates, associations, individuals, and others, and to give any guaranty in connection therewith or otherwise for the payment of money or for the performance of any other undertaking or obligation.
- (6) To conduct and carry on its business or any branch thereof in any state or territory of the United States or any foreign country in conformity with the laws of said state, territory, or foreign country, and to have and maintain in any state, territory, or foreign country, a business office, plant, or store.
- (7) To erect, construct, maintain, improve, rebuild, enlarge, alter, manage, and control, directly or through ownership of stock in any corporation, any and all kinds of buildings, houses, stores, offices, shops, warehouses, factories, mills, machinery, and plants and any and all other structures and erections which may at any time be necessary, useful, or advantageous, for the purpose of the corporation, and which can be lawfully done under the laws of the State of Idaho.
- (8) To do any or all the things set forth herein, to the same extent as a natural person might or could do within the State of Idaho, or any part of the world, as principals or agents, or otherwise, alone or in company with others, without restriction as to time, place, or amount.
- (9) To issue common stock and accept payment of subscriptions for the stock and installment payments, in such manner, or on such terms, in money or in property, real or personal, or both, as shall be determined by the board of directors to be feasible and advantageous.
 - (10) It is the intention that each of the powers specified

in each of the paragraphs herein, except where otherwise specified, shall not be limited or restricted by reference to or inference from the terms of any other paragraphs or of any other article, but that the powers and enumeration of specific powers shall not be construed to restrict in any manner the general terms and powers of the corporation, nor shall the expression of one thing be deemed to exclude another, though it be of like nature.

- (11) To engage in any business whatsoever, either as principal or as agent or both, or as a syndicate, which the corporation may deem convenient or proper or advantageous in furtherance of any of the purposes hereinabove mentioned or any proper and lawful purpose, and to conduct its business in this state, in other states in the District of Columbia, in the territories and possessions of the United States, and in foreign countries, and to have and to exercise all powers authorized by the laws of the State of Idaho under which the corporation is formed, whether expressly set forth in this paragraph or not, as such laws are now in effect or may at any time hereafter be amended.
- (12) To acquire any and all trademarks, trade names, trade symbols, logos, patents, copy rights, and other indications of origin and ownership granted by or recognized under the laws of the United States or any other country, state, territory, or locality.
- (13) To borrow money, and, from time to time, make, accept, endorse, execute, and issue bonds, debentures, promissory notes, bills of exchange, or other obligations of the corporation, for monies borrowed or in payment for property acquired, or for any of the other objects or purposes of the corporation or its business, and to secure payment of any such obligations by mortgage, pledge, deed, indenture, agreement, contract, or other instrument of trust, or by other lien upon, assignment of, or agreements in regard to, all or any part of the property, rights, or pledges of the corporation, wherever situated, whether now owned or hereafter to be acquired.

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(14) To enter into any kind of contract or agreement,
cooperative, or profit sharing plan, with its officers or employees
that the corporation may deem advantageous or expedient, or other-
wise to reward or pay such persons for their services, as the
board of directors may deem appropriate.

(15) Employee plans: From time to time to provide and carry out and to recall, abolish, revise, amend, alter, or change, a plan or plans for the participation by all or any of the employees, including directors and officers of this corporation, and for the furnishing to such employees and persons, at this corporation's expense, of medical services, dental services, insurance against accident, sickness or death, pensions during old age, disability, or unemployment, education, housing, social services, recreation, or other similar aids for their relief or general welfare, in such manner and upon such terms and conditions as may be determined appropriate and advantageous by the board of directors.

FIFTH:

SHARES OF STOCK

There shall be one class of shares, all of which shall be common shares.

The aggregate number of shares which this corporation shall have authority to issue is Five Thousand (5,000) shares, with a par value of One Dollar (\$1.00) per share, for an aggregate par value of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).

Each share shall have equal voting powers, with each share entitling the holder to one vote.

No shares shall be issued until the same are fully paid for, and when fully paid for the same shall be non-assessible. There shall be stated on each stock certificate in print the following: "THE SHARES REPRESENTED BY THIS CERTIFICATE ARE FULLY PAID FOR AND NON-ASSESSIBLE."

SIXTH:

PRE-EMPTIVE RIGHTS

When the board of directors so determines, each holder of

existing shares in this corporation shall have the first right to purchase shares of this corporation that may from time to time be issued, in the ratio that the number of shares he holds at the time of the issue bears to the total number of outstanding shares. This right shall be waived by any shareholder who does not exercise and pay for shares pre-empted within thirty (30) days of the receipt of a notice in writing from the corporation setting the prices, terms and conditions of the issues of shares and inviting him to exercise his pre-emptive rights. This statement of pre-emptive rights does not in any way inhibit or prohibit the directors from issuing stock in the form of stock options.

Shares of this corporation shall be issued only for cash or for services in kind, with the approval of the board of directors, to an amount not less than the aggregate par value of the shares being issued, or for consideration other than cash, the fair value of which to the corporation is not less than the aggregate par value of the shares prescribed for.

SEVENTH:

PROVISIONS FOR REGULATION OF THE CORPORATION'S INTERNAL AFFAIRS

Meetings of Shareholders and Directors: Meetings of the shareholders and directors of this corporation may be held within or without the State of Idaho, at such place or places as may from time to time be designated in the code of bylaws or by resolution of the board of directors.

Code of Bylaws: The initial code of bylaws of this corporation shall be adopted by its shareholders. The power to amend or repeal the bylaws or to adopt a new code of bylaws shall be in the shareholders, but the affirmative vote of the holders of two-thirds of the shares outstanding shall be necessary to exercise the power. The code of bylaws may contain any provisions for the regulation and management of this corporation which are consistent with the Idaho Business Corporation Act and these articles of incorporation.
