## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SENAT AND OF STATE ROLAND EVANS POST NO. 3, AMERICAN LEGION, INCORPORATED

We, the undersigned residents of the State of Idaho do associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a nonprofit corporation under the statutes of the State of Idaho.

Ι

The name of the corporation is ROLAND EVANS POST NO. 3, AMERICAN LEGION, INCORPORATED.

III

The period of its duration is perpetual.

III

This corporation is formed for social, benevolent and patriotic purposes, and especially, but not in limitation of its general powers:

To uphold and defend the Constitution of the United States of America; to maintain law and order; to foster and perpetuate a one hundred per cent Americanism; to preserve the memories and incidents of our association in the Great War; to inculcate a sense of individual obligation to the community, state and nation; to combat the autocracy of both the classes and the masses; to make right the master of might; to promote peace and good will on earth; to safeguard and transmit to posterity the principles of justice, freedom and democracy; to consecrate and sanctify our comradeship by our devotion to mutual helpfulness;

- B. To cultivate social intercourse amoung its members and assist in improving the health and physical condition of its members.
- C. To acquire, by purchase or otherwise, own, hold, manage, lease, sell and convey such real and personal property, and erect such buildings, memorials, club houses and other structures as may be necessary or incident to the carrying out of the purposes herein mentioned; to borrow money for the furtherance of such purposes and to secure the same by obligations, pledges, mortgages, or the issuance of bonds or debentures secured by pledges, deeds of trust, or mortgages of or upon the whole or any part of its property; to take and receive donations of real and personal property by gift, grant, devise or bequest:
- D. To manage and conduct entertainments, excursions, athletic contests and social meetings of its members; to promote and conduct entertainments, amusements and diversions to defray the expenses of this corporation; to promote and encourage the sport, pleasure, exercise and recreation of its members, and to enter into any and all contracts necessary in conducting its affairs; and to lend money, and render such benevolent aid and comfort to its members as may be provided by its by-laws; and to do any and all other things whatsoever which may be requisite, necessary and proper in and about the carrying out of the purposes and objects for which this corporation is formed.
