ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

MOUNTAIN VIEW SHORES, INC.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: That the undersigned, all/citizens of the United States, desire to and do hereby form a corporation in accordance with the laws of the State of Idaho, and do hereby make, adopt and subscribe the following ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION, in triplicate:

ARTICLE I.

The name of said corporation is MOUNTAIN VIEW SHORES, INC.

ARTICLE II.

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

- 1. To buy, sell, lease or otherwise acquire, dispose of, and generally deal in lands, or any interest therein and to construct buildings and/or make improvements thereon.
- 2. To subdivide and plat or otherwise develop or improve real estate, and to lay out, grade, pave or otherwise develop roads, streets, alleys, paths and walks, and to develop parks and playgrounds thereon.
- 3. To buy, lease, build or otherwise acquire plants, factories, tools, machinery, equipment and other facilities.
- 4. To buy, sell, manufacture, process and generally deal in all types of goods, wares and merchandise.
- 5. To buy, sell, and generally deal in stocks, bonds and other securities of individuals and corporations.
- 6. To buy, lease or otherwise acquire and to sell patents or rights to the use of any patented article.
- 7. To apply for and register, use and license trademarks and patents under the laws of the United States, or any foreign country.
- 8. To borrow money and to issue notes, bonds and other forms of obligation and to mortgage, pledge and hypothecate all or any part of the assets of the company, real or personal, as security for the payment thereof.
- 9. To borrow money from the United States, or any agency or subdivision thereof.
 - 10. To loan money, with or without security therefor.

- 11. To sell, lease, exchange or otherwise dispose of all or any part of the property and assets of the company, or merge or consolidate the same with another corporation, upon such terms and conditions as may be for the best interests of the corporation, as determined by the Board of Directors, and upon compliance with the law in respect thereto.
- 12. To have and exercise, and enjoy all other rights and privileges and powers now or hereafter granted to corporations under the laws of the State of Idaho, and all other powers incident to the foregoing general purposes in their fullest and broadest sense.

ARTICLE III.

The capital stock of this corporation is \$150,000.00 divided into 1500 shares of common stock of the par value of \$100.00 per share, which stock shall be non-assessable.

In the event of the dissolution or liquidation of the corporation the net proceeds from the liquidation thereof, after payment of all obligations, shall be distributed to the holders of the common stock.

ARTICLE IV.

The existence of this corporation shall be perpetual, unless dissolved or disincorporated as provided by law.

ARTICLE V.

The principal place of business and registered office and post office address of said corporation shall be: 607 Foster, Coeur d'Alene, Idaho.

ARTICLE VI.

The amount of paid-in capital with which the corporation will commence business is the sum of \$3,000.00.

ARTICLE VII.

The Board of Directors of said corporation shall consist of not less than three, or more than ten members, as may be determined by the stockholders from time to time, and the first Board of Directors, who shall serve until March 30, 1967, or until their successors are duly elected and qualified, and their post office addresses are as follows:
