## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

## PLANNED PARENTHOOD ASSOCIATION OF IDAHO, INC. A Non-Profit Corporation

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS: that we, the undersigned, being natural persons of full age and citizens of the United States, in order to form a non-profit corporation for the purposeshereinafter stated, pursuant to the laws of the State of Idaho, do hereby certify as follows:

#### Article I.

The name of this corporation shall be PLANNED PARENTHOOD.

ASSOCIATION OF IDAHO, INC.

### Article II.

The period of existence and the duration of life of this corporation shall be perpetual.

#### Article III.

The purposes for which said non-profit corporation is formed are:

- (a) To provide leadership for the universal acceptance of family planning as an essential element of responsible parenthood, stable family life, and social harmony through education for a family planning, the provision of the necessary services, the promotion of research in the field of human reproduction, and the study of the social and economic consequences of different rates of population growth.
  - (b) To own, lease, buy and sell both real and personal property.
- (c) To borrow money or otherwise incur indebtedness without limit as to the amount and to draw, make, accept, endorse, transfer, assign, guarantee, execute and issue bonds; debentures, notes, drafts,

bills of exchange, negotiable instruments, and all other instruments for the payment of money, negotiable and non-negotiable, secured and unsecured.

(d) To have, exercise, enjoin and participate in all the powers now or hereafter granted to corporations organized under the laws of this State, including any future amendments thereto and to do any acts or things necessary or convenient to carry out the foregoing objects and purposes.

#### Article IV.

This corporation shall not have capital stock and membership in this corporation shall be represented by certificates of membership, there being one certificate of membership per person. Each certificate of membership being entitled to one vote. The voting power, property rights and interest of each member are equal. A certificate of membership shall be issued to each person of the age of 16 years or older who pays annual dues of not less than \$1.00. New members shall be admitted upon the payment by each of them of the sum of not less than \$1.00 per year. Said new members shall be issued one certificate of membership each and shall be entitled to vote and to share in the property equally with the old members.

## Article V.

The principal place of business of this non-profit corporation shall be in the City of Boise, County of Ada, State of Idaho, which is bereby designated as the address of its registered office.

## Article VI.

### Article VII.

The management of this non-profit corporation shall be vested in a board of not less than three directors and a maximum number as may be fixed by the By-Laws. The directors shall be elected at the annual meeting of the members, to be held at a time and place designated by the By-Laws.

### Article VIII.

The Board of Directors of this non-profit corporation by a majority vote shall have the power to repeal or amend the By-Laws thereof, and to adopt a new code of By-Laws, if in their discretion that becomes proper.

### Article IX.

The private property of the members of this non-profit corporation shall not be subject to the payment of the corporate debts in any amount or to any extent whatsoever.

#### Article X.

In the event of the termination of existence of the organization for any cause whatever, all its assets and property over and above whatever may be required for the payment of its just debts and obligations, shall vest in the Planned Parenthood Federation of America or any organization successor thereto. Provided only that said Planned Parenthood Federation of America or its successor organization shall then, as now, be exempt from federal taxation and the contributions thereto shall likewise be exempt.
